

Steps for Readmission for Good Standing and Probation

Readmission Criteria

- Students who left in good academic standing or probation and are seeking readmission after an absence of two consecutive or more semesters (summer not included) may reapply for admissions.
- No additional admission criteria is needed for returning students who left in good or probation academic standing at Fresno State.
- Students who wish to return and pursue a different major must meet the impactation criteria for that major if there is such criteria. If they are returning in the same major, even if impacted, they can be readmitted without meeting the impactation criteria.

Admissions Application Process

- Apply for readmission at my.fresnostate.edu during the application filling period.
 - Fall application cycle (October 1st- January 15th) *.
 - Spring application cycle (August 1st-August 31st) *.
- After submitting an application, students must submit official transcripts by [document deadline](#).
 - Fall document deadline- February 1st *
 - Spring document deadline- September 15th *
- A student who has not attended Fresno State in 5 or more years must submit all official transcripts from previous institutions.
- A returning student who attended another college or institute after their last semester at Fresno State must submit all official transcripts from those institutions.
- Applications will be reviewed by Admissions & Recruitment. Students will be notified of their admissions prior to the semester beginning.
