Job Title: Early Childhood Assistant

Stone Soup Fresno (SSF) relies significantly on volunteer staff, especially students enrolled in Fresno State University. Working with the Program Director of Early Learning, this person will work with qualified/permitted teachers in both our Play Group (children 0-3 and their parents) and Preschool (children 3-5) programs. Other assignments may include activities associated with wrap-around support services, offered by our Parent Engagement Coordinator and Family Resource Specialist in areas of education advocacy and family strengthening. The qualified candidate is a student currently completing coursework in the area of early childhood development, education, social work, counseling, or similar career path. Bilingualism is a plus (Hmong, Lao, Khmer, Arabic, Spanish), but not a requirement for this position.

Hours are Monday-Friday, from 8 AM to 5 PM. However, this position can be flexible.
