ENP's vision is to mobilize these volunteer teams systematically throughout Fresno to engage every neighborhood so that schools are supported, students excel, families are healthy and whole and the community thrives.

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Job Title: Saturday Sports / Community Coordinator

Number of Openings: 3

On Site Coordinator (OSC) will holistically engage in Every Neighborhood Partnership's (ENP) Steps 1-4. OSC functions as a liaison within various partnerships at a designated school. OSC will build relationships with students, staff, parents, and volunteers to strengthen community involvement. OSC will work closely with ENP staff to develop a plan of engagement.

Hours and days will be dependent on a students' availability and partnership school needs. Students are encouraged to have at least 2 days on campus during the week and available on Saturday mornings for Saturday Sports.

Step 1 – Saturday Sports

Facilitate program sports or activities, arrive early to set up, sign in kids and volunteers, invite other volunteers and train other University volunteers.

Step 2 – Literacy Mentoring

Connect with teacher for classroom learning, additional support at lunch recess, invite other Fresno State students to serve on campus, coordinate volunteers for special projects.

Step 3 – Neighborhood Outreach

Help coordinate community projects, meetings, and help build relationships with other stakeholders in the neighborhood.

Step 4 – Parent Engagement

Attend parent gathering meetings, build relationships with parents work with parents to encourage Saturday Sports and other programs.
