FACE is a faith based CBO resource and training center for people and community groups that are collaborating for community transformation primarily in the Robinson Neighborhood. The after school sports club, tutoring club, and community dinners take place every Wednesday from 2:30pm-6:30pm. Elementary and middle school students from Robinson, McCardle and Awhanee Schools come to the campus of North Fresno Church to receive help with homework, improve reading skills, engage in recreational activities and share a hot meal together. Volunteer team usually consists of 5 adults and the number of students from the neighborhood who attend average between 15-25.
