 - Withholding adoption information could violate laws regarding students with disabilities. Advanced notice is needed prior to classes beginning.
 - Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA) requires information on course materials be posted at time of registration.
 - Kennel Bookstore is the curator of course materials- bypassing the Bookstore places the campus at risk for compliance with HEOA.
