

POLICY FOR DISPLAY OF FLAG AT HALF STAFF

The flag of the United States is flown at California State University, Fresno pursuant to Federal guidelines.

The President of the United States, the Governor of California, the Chancellor of the California State University system, or the President of California State University, Fresno, or designee, may declare a period of mourning whereby the flag may be flown at half-staff.

The President of California State University, Fresno, grants the authorization to fly the flag at half-staff for one day due to the death of one of the following:

- Dignitary
- Student of the University
- Former student of the University
- University employee
- University retiree
- University faculty
- University faculty emeritus

A University employee may notify the on-duty supervisor at the University Police Department and request that the flag be flown at half-staff for the aforementioned. The on-duty supervisor shall verify the merit of the request and notify University Relations for dissemination of information.

The President of California State University, Fresno, or designee, may also authorize the flying of the flag at half-staff out of respect for events, occurrences, or based on discretionary consideration.

The University Police Department shall be responsible for following the protocols of displaying the flag at the University.
