Abstract of not more than 300 words, single-spaced using 12-point font. Do not use technical jargon. Do not indent the first line of each paragraph. Leave one blank line between paragraphs. Leave 1 1/2" left and right margins.

Authors of papers must be sponsored by a faculty member.

Abstracts which are selected will be published in the proceedings exactly as typed. The title should be brief but long enough to identify clearly the nature of the study. The body of the abstract should be organized as follows:

- a. An introduction stating objectives of the study.
- b. A brief summary of methods.
- c. A summary of results. (It is not satisfactory to state "the results will be discussed.")
- d. A statement of conclusions reached.

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS
DEADLINE: SUNDAY, MARCH 17, 2013**

- All fields of research will be considered for presentation to exchange further ideas among investigators and the general public.
- Comparative analysis, data, and results of completed research or research in advanced stages of completion must be described in the abstract. Authors should indicate their preference for either an oral or a poster presentation.
- Abstracts will be selected by a committee based on the following criteria: scholarly merit appropriate to the discipline, creativity, timeliness, value, and clarity to an audience of scholars not necessarily from the same discipline. The most frequent reason for rejection of proposals is absence of results. **Abstracts should not contain technical jargon and undefined symbols.**
- Oral presentations will be limited to 15 minutes including discussion. Notification of acceptance will specify location and exact time of presentation. Because of limited facilities, no more than one presentation may be made by an individual author. This does not preclude a co-author from making a presentation.
- Details of the poster format will be provided to authors selected for a poster presentation.
- Abstracts selected for presentation will be published in the Central California Research Symposium Proceedings and on the ORSP website.
- Student awards will be followed by a social hour.

Judges attending the oral sessions and the poster session will recommend undergraduate students for cash awards.
