#### **Senior Hospital Administrators from China Will Visit Fresno Hospitals to Learn About Healthcare Practices**

Fresno, Calif. – Senior hospital administrators from major cities in China will be visiting Fresno on an invitation from the Lyles Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurship to learn more about best practices and hospital administration from leaders in Fresno healthcare.

“We are honored to be selected as the city of choice for a site visit to learn about hospital administration,” said Dr. Timothy M. Stearns, Executive Director of the Lyles Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurship. “Fresno has a rich tradition in hospital administration leadership and we are pleased to receive such international prominence.”

The group of administrators is organized by the Ministry of Public Health of China. The Hospital Management Workshop will take place May 20, through May 21.

The group of administrators will visit Children’s Hospital Central California, St. Agnes Medical Center, and Kaiser Medical Center Fresno over the visit.

During the two day workshop they will be touring and meeting with senior executives from these hospitals to learn about Fresno healthcare. Among the topics the delegates will be hearing about are management systems, quality services, and the management philosophy of an American hospital.

In addition to the hospital visits, Lynne Ashbeck, the Regional Vice President for the Hospital Council of Northern and Central California will be presenting the history and the philosophy of hospital management to the senior administrators.
