PROCEDURES

The number of signatures required to put a name in nomination is **FIFTEEN (15). A PERSON MAY SIGN ONLY ONE PETITION.**

NOMINATING PETITIONS and STATEMENTS OF ELIGIBILITY are available in the Academic Senate Office, UC #205. The Academic Senate Bylaws state: "Nominating petitions shall be accompanied by a declaration from the nominee that they do and/or agree to meet the eligibility requirements of the office for which they are being nominated and that they will fill the office if elected." The nominee should forward a short statement of qualifications to accompany the ballot.

Petitions must be returned to the Academic Senate Office and Statements emailed to sharonh by 4:00 p.m., MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2007.
