The Academic Senate Bylaws state: "Nominating petitions shall be accompanied by a declaration from the nominee that they do and/or agree to meet the eligibility requirements of the office for which they are being nominated and that they will fill the office if elected." The nominee should forward a short statement of qualifications to accompany the ballot.

Petitions must be returned to the Academic Senate Office and Statements emailed to sharonh by 4:00 p.m., TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 12, 2008.
