The meeting was called to order by Chair O. Benavides at 1:00 p.m. in the Education Building room # 316.

The Chancellor's Office will provide some additional (170) access points to be added to the 237 already installed. Also, chancellor's Office is providing 802.11n upgradable standard.

3. Draft Telecommunications Rate Change Frequently Asked Questions.

R. Boes, at the request of IETCC, presented a report on proposed ITS chargebacks on the new telephone system, including a change in rate structure. R. Boes responded to various questions from committee members. Selection of a vendor is planned for next week.

The committee talked with R. Boes about other topics, including licensing of important software, accessibility materials and issues, etc.

4. Student Laptop Configuration [see 2008StudentLaptopConfig-draft.xls].

D. Martin asked the AIT Committee to “to review the attached configurations of a Dell Inspiron 1420 and Apple MacBook laptop as the current minimum recommended system for new students. The bookstore has asked us, as in the past, for input for the flyer they will be distributing to new students. Please note that CVIP does not currently distribute Antivirus software but will be soon. The products will be Sophos for Apple systems and Trend Micro for PC. We have purchased the licenses for students and faculty/staff home use but have not resolved the issue with the update mechanism that would need to expire when students graduate.”

The proposed configuration will be referred to ITS for review. Some known problems were observed, e.g., the anti-virus software, the wireless card, MS Vista OS, and some others. What is a minimum baseline level for each element in the configuration? This standard is different from a recommended standard. Laptops to do video applications might have different standards than other baseline units.
