4. Campus Parking Policy

The Committee continued its discussion of proposed revisions to the visitor parking policy. M. Babick distributed a revised set of regulations that have been prepared in his office in consultation with Vice President Matson. FACEL members suggested several changes. It was agreed that M. Babick will discuss these revisions with Vice President Matson and others and bring a final version to the next FACEL meeting, and that the final version will be submitted directly to the Academic Senate by FACEL before the end of the semester.

5. Update on Campus Construction Projects.

- A. G. Wilson noted that revised bids for the swimming complex will be opened next week.
- B. Over the summer, the North Gym restrooms will be remodeled to meet accessibility requirements.

- C. The remodeling of the nursing labs in the "H" wing of McLane will also take place over the summer.
- D. Beginning work towards the revision of the HVAC system in the AG building has begun with the temporary move of several offices to the University Center Building.
- E. The parking lot pavement next to McLane Hall was restriped over the Spring Break.
- F. There was considerable discussion regarding the library. It was noted that the Leo Poleit Garden on the east side of the building, south of the main entrance, is under construction. Discussion then moved to problems within the library caused by numbers of people eating food throughout the building. This is causing significant problems for janitorial services and potentially with vermin. Discussion will need to be initiated with the library and Starbucks regarding limiting the areas where food may be consumed.
- G. G. Wilson noted that the power outages last week were successfully completed with new lines installed to the east side of campus.
- H. The committee working on the new building for the Gibson Farm Market will hold its first meeting next week.
