No refunds are allowed on or after Monday, April 04, 2016.

Refunds are calculated on a calendar day basis from the first day of instruction to the last day of exams, excluding breaks in instruction of five (5) consecutive days or more. Refunds are allowed to the 60th percentile of the semester. For Spring 2016, first day of instruction is January 19, 2016, and the last day of exams is May 19, 2016. Each day within the semester is 1/113 of the semester.

Refund amounts have been rounded off to the nearest whole dollar on this schedule. Actual refunds are calculated using dollars and cents and your actual refund may vary slightly from what is shown on this schedule.
