

Spring 2017 Tuition Fee Payment Plan for Residents Terms and Provisions

The California State University (CSU) makes every effort to keep student costs to a minimum. Fees listed in published schedules or student accounts may need to be increased when public funding is inadequate. Therefore, CSU must reserve the right, even after fees are initially charged or initial fee payments are made, to increase or modify any listed fees. All listed fees, other than mandatory systemwide fees, are subject to change without notice, until the date when instruction for a particular semester or quarter has begun. All CSU listed fees should be regarded as estimates that are subject to change upon approval by the Board of Trustees, the Chancellor, or the Presidents, as appropriate. Changes in mandatory systemwide fees will be made in accordance with the requirements of the Working Families Student Fee Transparency and Accountability Act (Sections 66028 - 66028.6 of the Education Code).

Payment Plan Schedule

California State University, Fresno instituted a Tuition Fee Payment Plan with guidelines from the CSU Chancellor's Office. This optional plan enables students to defer a portion of their tuition fee. Course, professional program, non-resident tuition fees, and all other fees are not deferrable.

Terms and Provisions

1. Students who apply for financial aid, or obtain a waiver or deferral of tuition and other fees, are not eligible to participate since payment is waived/deferred through that process
2. The Tuition Fee Payment Plan defers a portion of tuition only. Course Fees, Professional Program Fees, Non-Resident Tuition Fees, Student Involvement & Representation Fee and all other fees are not deferred
3. There is a \$33.00 non-refundable administrative costs fee
4. The contract must be signed and turned in with 1) first installment and 2) administrative fee, payments. See Payment Plan Schedule above for fee rates
5. Payments and contracts must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. Friday, January 13, 2017
6. Payments and contracts not received by Friday, January 13, 2016, will result in disenrollment of all classes
7. The second Installment payment is due by 5:00 p.m. Monday, February 13, 2017
8. Payments not received by installment due dates will result in the disenrollment of classes and forfeiture of all tuition and fees paid to date
9. The last day to opt out of the \$2.00 Student Involvement & Representation Fee is Monday, February 13, 2017
