

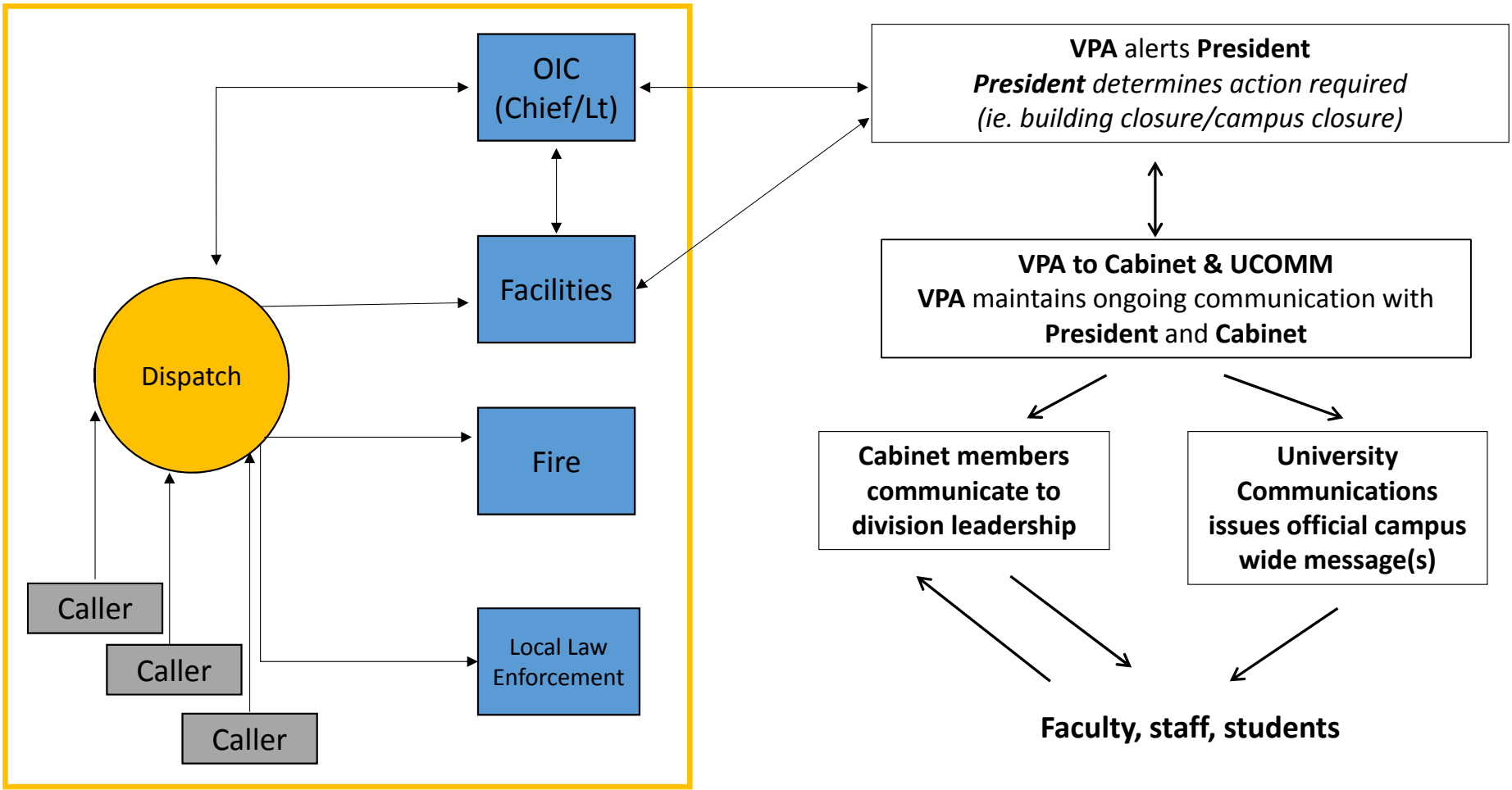

What Should You Do?


To prepare:

- Identify all exit routes
- Know where evacuation assembly point is
- Identify a shelter in place location
- Create a communication plan within your department
- Schedule training with department
- Practice your plans

In case of emergency:

- Remain Calm
- Remember your plan
 - Lock/Barricade yourself inside office or classroom
 - Turn down lights
 - Stay away from windows
 - Use movable furniture to help barricade door
 - Evacuate if instructed to do so
 - Help those around you
 - Check official Campus Information Sources

- Campus exterior lighting improvements
- Dedicated position created for Emergency Preparedness
- TipNow (anonymous reporting system)
- Safety Escorts
- Emergency Preparedness Training
 - Table topic exercises
 - Seconds 2 Survive

Next Steps/Follow Up

- Formalize and share Emergency Communication Plan
- Timing/Content/Frequency of emergency communications
- Safety Training Programs:
 - Department-Specific Planning
 - S2S Trainings Schedule: Nov. 30 @ 9:30, Dec. 1 @ 1:30, Dec. 3 @ 10:00
- Enact Website alert functionality
- Convene a Crisis (emergency) Communications Team
- Change On-Hold Message
- Activate 278-4000 (hotline) earlier with more frequent updates
- Schedule Test #2 of bulldog alert system
- Update emergency website www.fresnostate.edu/emergency
