General Assignment:

Under the direction of the Director of Strength and Conditioning Coach, the incumbent will be responsible to assist with the daily operations of the strength and conditioning program for varsity student-athletes; provide proper supervision and instruction on safe equipment usage; conduct fitness evaluations; assist in the design and implementation of strength and conditioning programs for a variety of men's and women's athletic teams and individual athletes as assigned by the Director of Strength and Conditioning which includes: supervision and teaching progression, resistance, cardiovascular, speed, explosive/plyometric, flexibility and body control, secondary injury rehabilitation, record keeping and monitoring progress.

The specific duties of the position will include assisting with the supervision of the volunteer assists, assist the Director of Strength and Conditioning with the scheduling of teams and strength training for the facility, preparation and presentation for clinics and strength camps as required, and conduct fitness evaluations.

Required Education, Experience, Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Bachelor's degree in physical education, exercise science or related field from an institution of higher education which is accredited by one of the six US regional accrediting associations or by an equivalent international institution of higher education.
- Minimum of two years of full time experience in strength and conditioning at the Division I level
- CSCCA or CSCS accredited National Certification as required by NCAA regulations by August 1, 2015
- Experience and demonstrated ability in the design and implementation of safe and effective strength programs for a variety of sports
- To understand the importance of cleanliness of facility and safety when dealing with blood borne pathogens and skin contact
- Ability to:
 - show enthusiasm and positive attitude on a daily basis
 - support the equity and diversity commitments of the department
 - work and communicate well with strength staff, student athletes, and other coaches
 - work effectively with individuals from diverse ethnic, cultural and socio-economic backgrounds and project a professional attitude
 - Assist Director and staff with weekly scheduling of teams facility use
 - Act as a competent mentor for yearly interns and graduate assistants
- A history of regular attendance and positive performance evaluations
- Computer skills related to designing off-season and summer workout booklets, through Excel and other specific software

Preferred Experience, Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Strong knowledge of teaching and implementing Olympic lifts preferred
- Preparation and presentation for clinics and strength camps preferred
