General Assignment:

Under the general supervision of the Director for Student-Athlete Services, the Academic Advisor is responsible for understanding and interpreting relevant university, NCAA and MWC policies to provide academic, graduation, eligibility, career, and personal advising for student-athletes; providing regular academic and athletic eligibility progress reports to coaching staff; assisting with study hall services; teaching new student orientation courses on academic success strategies; and providing academic and eligibility information to prospective student-athletes and parents, and other duties as assigned.

- Bachelor's degree from an institution of higher education which is accredited by one of the six US regional accrediting associations or by an equivalent international institution of higher education
