General Assignment:

Under the direction of the Director of Strength and Conditioning Coach, the incumbent will be responsible to assist with the daily operations of the strength and conditioning program for varsity student-athletes; provide proper supervision and instruction on safe equipment usage; conduct fitness evaluations; assist in the design and implementation of strength and conditioning programs for a variety of men's and women's athletic teams and individual athletes as assigned by the Director of Strength and Conditioning which includes: supervision and teaching progression, resistance, cardiovascular, speed, explosive/plyometric, flexibility and body control, secondary injury rehabilitation, record keeping and monitoring progress; prepare presentations for clinics and strength camps; design off-season and summer workout booklets utilizing Excel and other computer software; assist Director and staff with weekly scheduling of teams and facility use; and act as competent mentor for yearly interns and graduate assistants.
