Fresno State beat out the competition to have Summer Arts return to its campus. Go Dogs!

- Summer Arts (SART) staff are in Long Beach until June when they come to Fresno State shortly before the start of classes.
- Requests for registration begin in January. These requests can include artist portfolios/auditions and scholarship applications.
- These applications need to be created and maintained in two databases, at Summer Arts and Fresno State.
- The students need to be registered into their classes at Fresno State, fees need to be assessed, grades assigned, and Chancellor's Office reports generated.
- When Summer Arts was last at Fresno, this was a heavily paper driven and manual process during a very busy period. So, our task was to improve the processes and procedures for both groups.

How do we make this a better experience for Summer Arts, Admissions & Records, and Student Accounts?

- Create a Summer Arts App which can be placed on the Summer Arts webpage and students will use to begin the application/registration process.
- When applicants/students, select the courses they want to register in, let them know if there are course fees involved, an estimated tuition and other fees total, and allow them to attach supporting documents.
- Include a scholarship application for students who want to apply for one.
- Create custom Summer Arts reports in PeopleSoft to show SART and FS staffs the status of the students. One report for the SART staff to update and the FS staff to respond by making changes, another inquiry report.
- Ensure that the Chancellor's Office reporting can be done successfully at the end of the summer.
