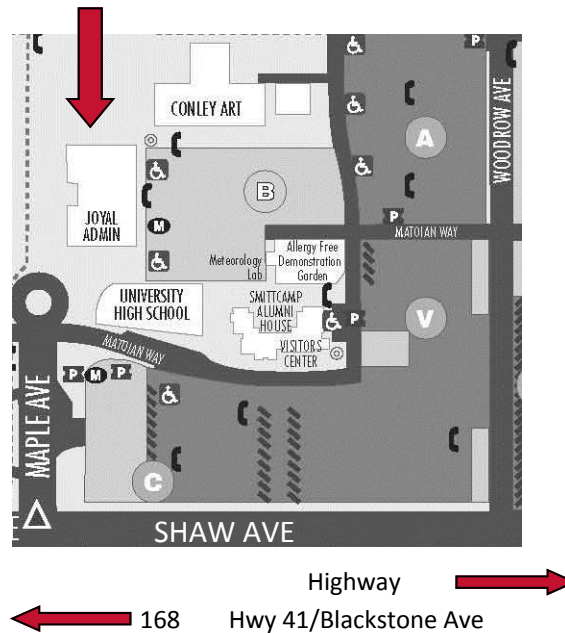

Public Works & Professional Services Bidding

Public Works projects are divided into Major Capitol (\$610,000+) and Minor Capitol projects (<\$610,000). To compete for Major Capitol projects, your company must register with the CSU Chancellor's Office at www.calstate.edu/cpdc/CM

Contractors interested in Minor Capital projects must prequalify with the Procurement Office at Fresno State by attending a MiniBid Orientation with a Public Works Buyer. You may call at any time to schedule your appointment.

Professional Services related to Public Works projects may include Inspectors of Record, architects, engineers, project managers, abatement/testing services, designers and consultants.

Minor capital Professional Services are selected on an as-needed basis directly by Facilities Management.

Major Capital Architects must prequalify with the CPDC Division of the CSU Chancellor's Office at: www.calstate.edu/cpdc/ae/prequal
