After spending five dangerous years hiding in the jungles of Laos and a year in a refugee camp, Dr. Song Lee knows the challenges of establishing a life and an identity in a new country. The Fresno State alumna and assistant professor recently won a top award from the American Counseling Association for her research into identity and mental health among Hmong women.

In the Central Valley, home to the one of the nation's largest Hmong populations, Dr. Lee's work brings critical awareness of multicultural issues. She serves as a role model and inspiration to the Hmong and other cultures, both inside the classroom and out.
