Schoolyard disputes are nothing new, but the award-winning Fresno State Mediator Mentors program helps those conflicts end peacefully while teaching children skills for life.

Under the direction of Dr. Pam Lane-Garon of the Kremen School of Education and Human Development, Fresno State students have trained and mentored youngsters to resolve disputes with their peers at 50 Central Valley schools. So far, more than 3,000 children and teachers have taken part.
