



# Creating a Healthier Valley

A \$4.5 million grant from the National Institutes of Health will allow Fresno State to develop a state-of-the-art biomedical research facility.

Under the direction of chemistry professor Dr. Krish Krishnan, the award will fund a program targeting important community health needs, everything from the effects of pesticides on breast cancer in Hispanic farmworkers to the links between air pollution, viral infection and asthma in the Central Valley.

Through the grant, Fresno State will partner with several renowned research facilities, including UC San Francisco-Fresno, UC Davis Medical Center and the California Cancer Registry.
