

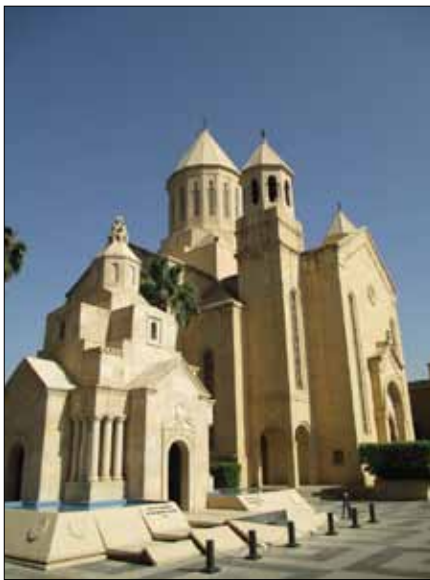

Prof. Der Mugrdechian will discuss the significance of the Armenian community in Lebanon, one of the most important Diasporan centers. The Armenians have maintained a vibrant communal life in the midst of the general political instability of the Middle East. Der Mugrdechian’s talk will focus on the current community and the challenges that it faces, while emphasizing the continued vitality of the Armenians in Lebanon. Der Mugrdechian was invited by the Tekeyan Cultural Association to Beirut in the summer of 2016 to give a talk. While in Lebanon he visited the major Armenian institutions in the country.

Barlow Der Mugrdechian is Director of the Armenian Studies Program at California State University, Fresno. He has been teaching courses in Armenian language, culture, art, and history for the past thirty-one years.
