Dr. Quintard Taylor, Jr., Ph.D., held the Scott and Dorothy Bullitt Professor of American History at the University of Washington and is the author of *In Search of the Racial Frontier: African Americans and the American West, 1528-1990*; *Seeking El Dorado: African Americans in California*; *African American Women Confront the West*, and numerous other scholarly books and articles. Dr. Taylor is also the founder of Blackpast.org, the Google of the Africana experience. At present he is a Professor Emeritus at the University of Washington.
