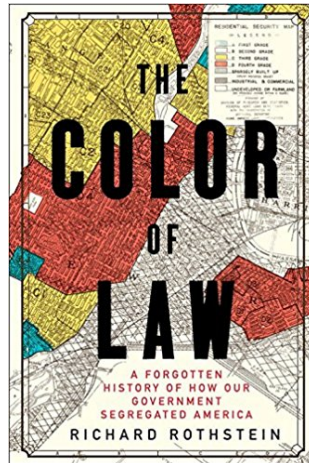




LEON S. PETERS ETHICS LECTURE

Richard Rothstein will speak about his recent book, *The Color of Law*, examining how segregation in America is the byproduct of explicit government policies at the local, state, and federal levels. Rothstein works with the Economic Policy Institute, the Thurgood Marshall Institute of the NAACP Legal Defense Fund, and is a professor at the UC Berkeley School of Law. He is the author of many books and a former *New York Times* columnist.
