Robert Dick lives in New York City and is on the faculty of New York University. He holds a B.A. from Yale University and an M.M. in composition from the Yale School of Music. As a composer/performer, Robert Dick is one of only two Americans ever to be awarded both Composers Fellowships (twice) and a Solo Recitalist Grant by the N.E.A. He has received a Guggenheim Fellowship and commissions from the Jerome Foundation, Fromm Music Foundation, Mary Flagler Cary Trust, the city of Zurich, the Philharmonie in Cologne and many more. As one of the flute world's most respected master class teachers, Robert Dick has been in residence in literally hundreds of universities, colleges and conservatories throughout the US, Europe, Asia and Australia. Dr. Teresa Beaman, flute, is Professor of Music at CSU, Fresno, where she has taught since 1986. As a performer and clinician, she has appeared throughout much of the United States, as well as in South America, Europe, Asia, Australia and New Zealand. She has coordinated the annual Central California Flute Festival since 1991 (2010 Festival is February 13, 2010). She served as Treasurer of the National Flute Association, and on the Board of Directors and as Secretary. Her *Flute Moments* CD was sponsored by the NEA and her *Flute Flora* CD was partially funded by the CSU. She earned BA and MM degrees at Yale, where she studied with Thomas Nyfenger, and a DMA from the State University of New York at Stony Brook, where she studied with Samuel Baron.
