

Student-run theatre company brings Agatha Christie classic to the stage.

(October 30, 2017) - [Fresno State's Experimental Theatre Company](#) announces their Fall 2017 production, 'And Then There Were None' by Agatha Christie. The production is directed by Fresno State student, Jana Price and will run November 9th until November 12th in the Lab School 101 Theatre.

Ten strangers are summoned to a remote island. All that the guests have in common is a wicked past they're unwilling to reveal and a secret that will seal their fate. For each has been marked for murder. As the weather turns and the group is cut off from the mainland, the bloodbath begins and one by one they are brutally murdered in accordance with the lines of a sinister nursery rhyme.

One of Christie's darkest tales and a masterpiece of dramatic construction, its growing sense of dread and unflinching tension will keep you guessing to the very end.

Director Jana Price calls her production, "An immersive experience where even the audience will wonder if they'll be the next to go."
