Advising Notes

1. Students must earn a grade of at least C in each course.
2. All minors also require a 2.0 GPA and 6 upper-division units in residence.
3. No course taken for the business minors can be graded on a CR/NC basis except for courses with mandatory CR/NC grading. Courses in a major cannot be applied toward a minor unless designated as "additional requirements."
