

- Pay in larger manual installments.
- Payment methods accepted: Visa or MasterCard, ATM/debit card/credit card or personal checks.
- Payment schedule:
 - o \$95 non-refundable deposit due upon registration
 - o \$500 due 30 days after enrollment
 - o \$500 due 90 days after enrollment
 - o Remaining balance due 95 days prior to departure

EF's program pricing is rolling, with the best price guaranteed for participants that enroll early. The program price and discount is valid for the month of October. Once a traveler enrolls, they lock in their program price (unless it happens to go down, in which case we will adjust enrolled travelers' balances to the new best price). The program price will be reevaluated every month, and it is possible this program price may increase.

EF REFUND SCHEDULE

150 days or more prior to departure Full refund less the \$95 non-refundable deposit, all non-refundable fees, and a \$300 cancellation fee.

149 to 95 days prior to departure Full refund less the \$95 non-refundable deposit, all non-refundable fees, and a \$500 cancellation fee.

94 to 45 days prior to departure Full refund less the \$95 non-refundable deposit, all non-refundable fees, and 50% of the program price.

44 days or less prior to departure No refund will be issued.

CGE REFUND SCHEDULE

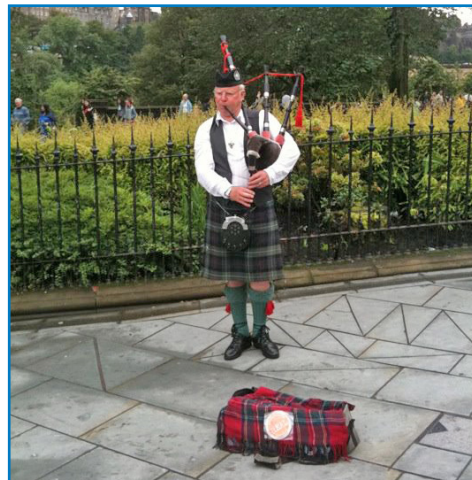
If you withdraw from the program, you will be eligible for a full refund of your CGE tuition if you withdraw before February 2, 2018. Beginning February 2, 2018, no refunds will be made. If you withdraw from the program on or after February 2, 2018, the university will place a hold on your student account and require you to pay the full amount of tuition fees (\$870) for the travel study program. Further, you will be unable to register in future Fresno State classes until this financial obligation is paid in full.
