Certificate Award in

Medical Interpreting

FALL 2017/SPRING 2018

This 80-hour online curriculum is designed to train interested bilingual candidates to serve as Professional Medical Interpreters. This program will address patient/provider communication, cultural awareness during an intervention, interpreter code of ethics, and the role of the interpreter in the healthcare and administrative setting. Program curriculum was developed around the necessary criteria to assure quality training and assessment based on the National Council on Interpreting in Health Care and Certification Commission for Healthcare Interpreters.

This program consists of two required courses: Introduction to Medical Interpreting (Fall 2017) and Advanced Medical Interpreting (Spring 2018). Each course will have 40 hours of online instruction. Participants must complete Introduction to Medical Interpreting course with a grade of C or higher in order to be allowed to proceed to the second course. Participants who complete both courses, with an average grade of C or higher, will receive a certificate of completion.

This certificate program will prepare candidates for the National Board of Certification for Medical Interpreter and the Certification Commission for Healthcare Interpreters. The program focuses on topics that will prepare participants for both certification programs for both exams. We are not affiliated with either certification programs. Participants will independently select the certification program of their choice.

Participants must pass a written or an on-line version Medical Interpreting Entrance Exam to test their proficiency in English and Spanish. Participants successfully completing the exam with a passing score of 70% or higher will gain entrance into the program in Fall, 2017. Certificate Award in Medical Interpreting – Fall 2017/Spring 2018

Admission Requirements:

You may be admitted to the program if you 1) have completed at least a high school education or its equivalent, 2) possess a high level of oral skills in Spanish and English, 3) are highly motivated, 4) possess people skills and 5) have passed the Medical Interpreting Entrance Exam.

Introduction to Medical Interpreting

Pre-Requisite: Passing the Medical Interpreting Entrance Exam or Court Interpreting Entrance Exam (offered in previous semesters).

The class will provide bilingual participants with: an Introduction to Medical Interpreting techniques, theory, concepts, medical terminology, professional development, healthcare interpreter standards and cultural awareness and the modes of interpreting; focusing on consecutive interpreting. The class will teach the skills required to handle and control the flow of the sessions, provide an in-depth discussion of ethical principles, and discuss strategies that will assist the participants on how to handle the challenges presented on a day-to-day basis.

Advanced Medical Interpreting

Coming Spring, 2018

Pre-Requisite: Passing Introduction Medical Interpreting course with a grade of C or higher.

40 hours; Online Course

The class will provide bilingual participants with an extensive understanding to medical interpreting techniques, theory, concepts, and skills. Extensive coverage in medical subspecialty terminology: anatomy, medical specialties (children and adult), understanding legal consents, and living wills. There will be an introduction to Administrative Interpreting covering examinations and procedures, administrative interpreting versus medical interpreting. This class will further develop the bilingual participants interpreting skills; build terminology and prepare them for oral medical/healthcare certification exam.
