PROGRAM

Sevilla is a culturally rich city in the historical country of Spain. A special session of SPAN 3 and SPAN 125 offers students the opportunity to live in and experience one of the cultures that has influenced many of the cultures in this hemisphere, while improving their skills in reading and writing the Spanish language. Students live with host families and are immersed in Spanish language and culture. Included in the overall cost of the trip is lodging with families, half-day classes, excursions, lectures and cultural tours. Cultural excursions, include trips to Granada and Córdoba, as well as a weekend trip to Barcelona.

Early registration is strongly encouraged. Proof of a valid passport is required prior to the trip. Any disability requiring special attention must be reported to the instructor.

PROGRAM FEE

The fee of \$3,100 includes:

REGISTRATION FEE & PAYMENT

All participants in this program must register for credit, including non-matriculated individuals.

Course fee is \$3,100. The first payment of \$1,550 is due to the Division of Continuing and Global Education on February 3, 2017 and the balance of \$1,550 is due on April 3, 2017.

It is important to understand that you are undertaking a serious contractual obligation when you register for your travel study

program. Starting on February 3, 2017, you are responsible for all your travel study program fees of \$3,100, which will be posted to your account even if you withdraw from the program.
