THE PROGRAM

Salamanca, Spain is a culturally rich city in the historical country of Spain. Much of the history of the Americas and their cultural heritage relates to the influence of Spain. Students live with host families and are immersed in Spanish language and culture. Included in the overall cost of the trip is lodging with families, half-day classes, excursions, lectures and cultural tours. Tours will be to Oporto, Portugal and Segovia, and Avila, Spain.



Students will gain an educational experience that will stay with them for the rest of their lives as one of the most influential periods in their education. They will live the culture and language that they have been studying. They will see for themselves historical sites that most people only read about or see in photos and movies.

Early enrollment is strongly encouraged. Proof of a valid passport is required prior to the trip. Any disability requiring special attention must be reported to the instructor.

Program Fee

Travel medical insurance (medical insurance is required of all participants and must be purchased by March 26, 2012 at www.csuhealthlink.com for approximately \$47); passport; and tips for porters, tour leaders, drivers, waiters, and hotel staff.

Course Payment Schedule

Course fee is \$3,500. A \$1,000 deposit is due to the Division of Continuing and Global Education by February 20, 2012 and the balance of \$2,500 is due on April 16, 2012. Check must be made payable to "Fresno State". *Note: all fees are subject to change*
