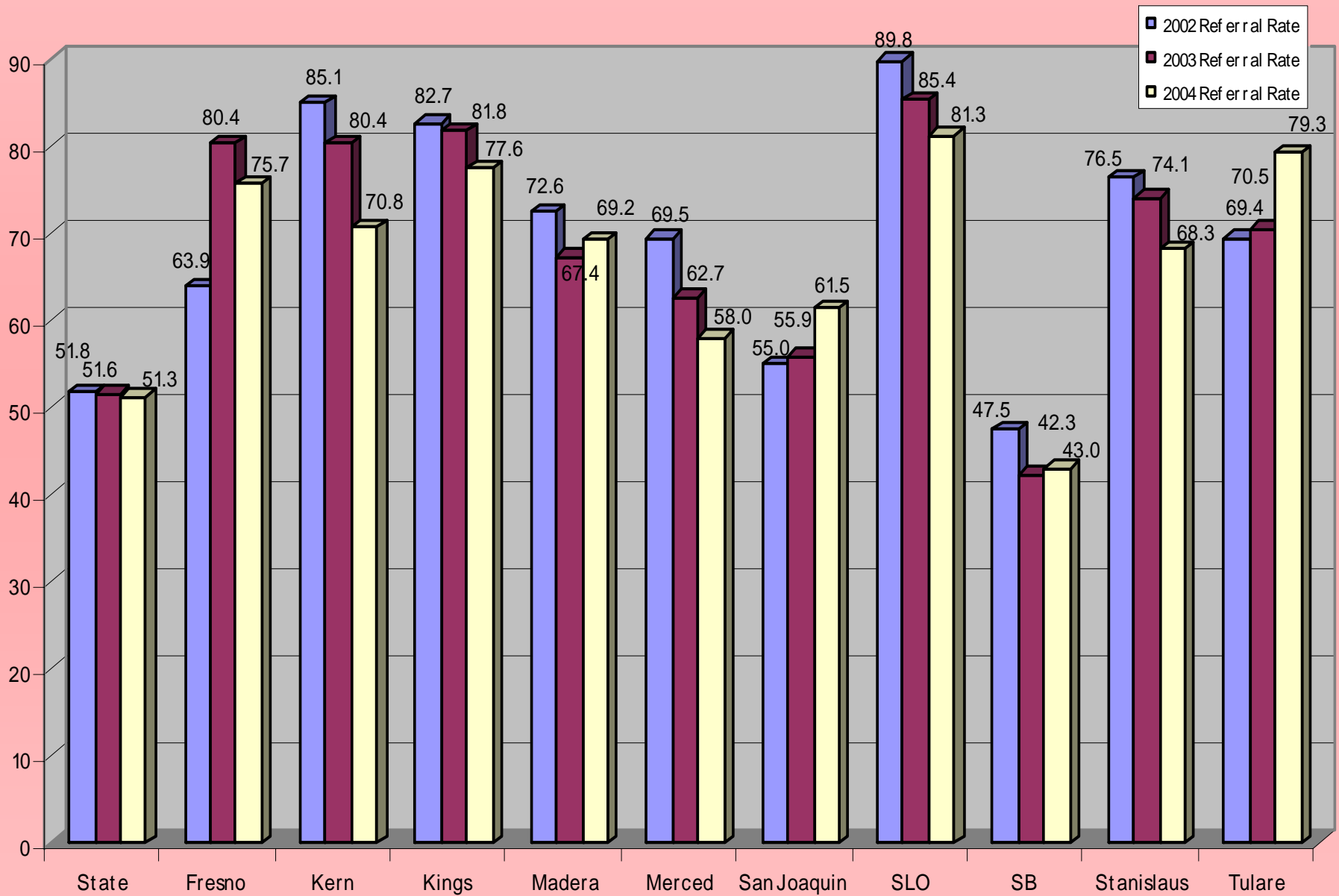

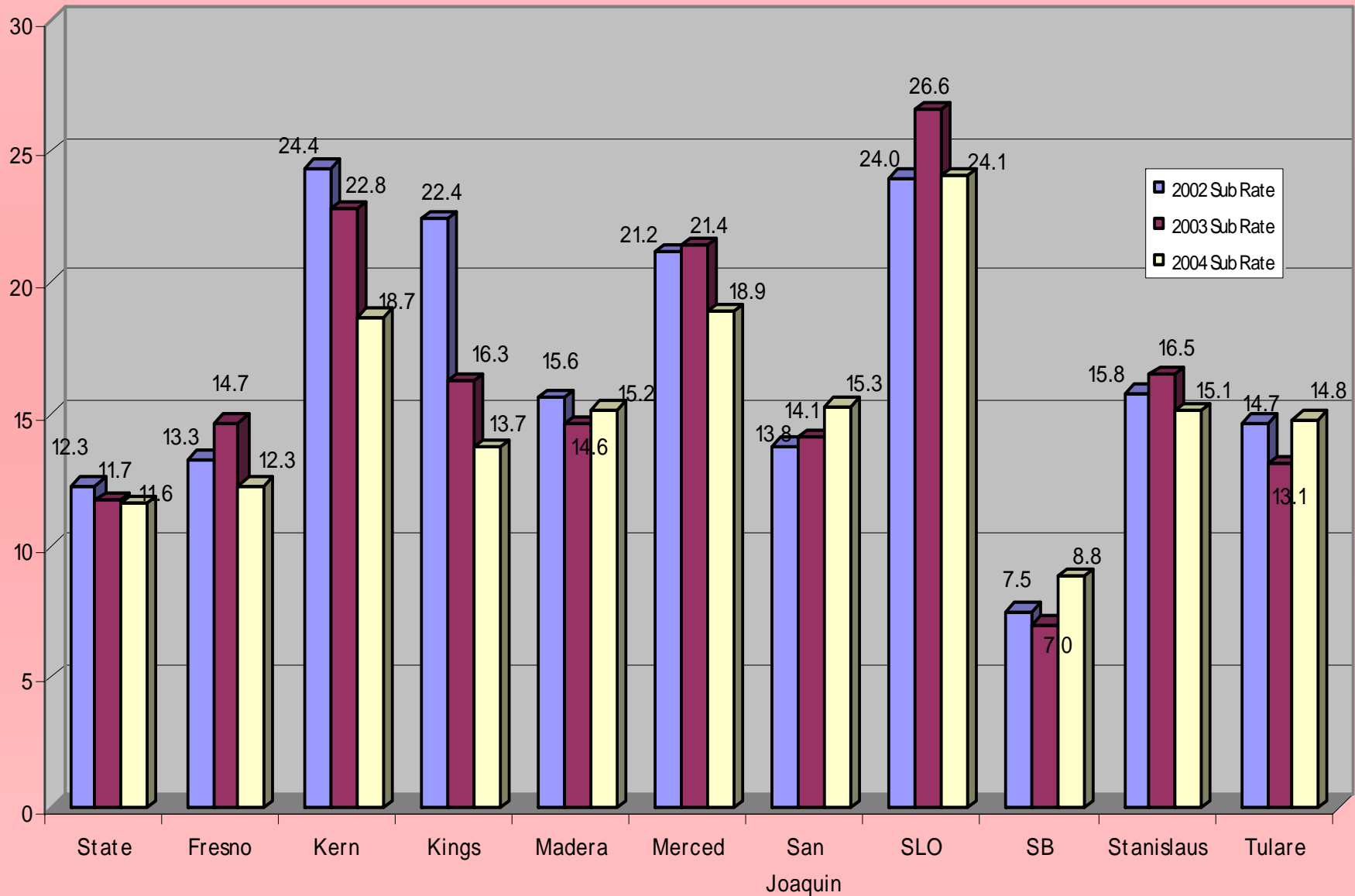

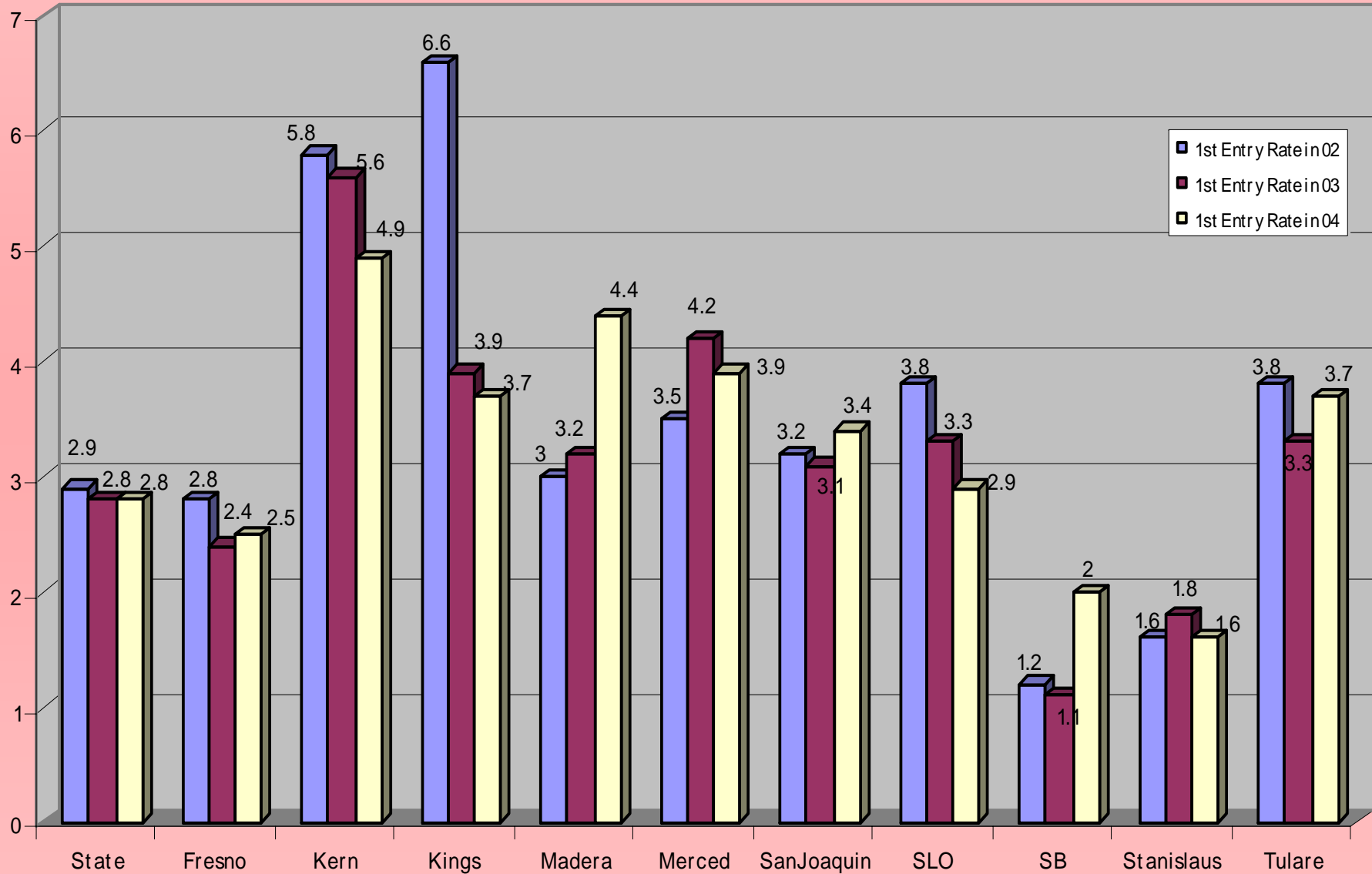
# Referral Rates per 1000 Children – 2002-2003-2004

# 1<sup>st</sup> Entry Rate into Foster Care per 1000 children 2002-2003-2004

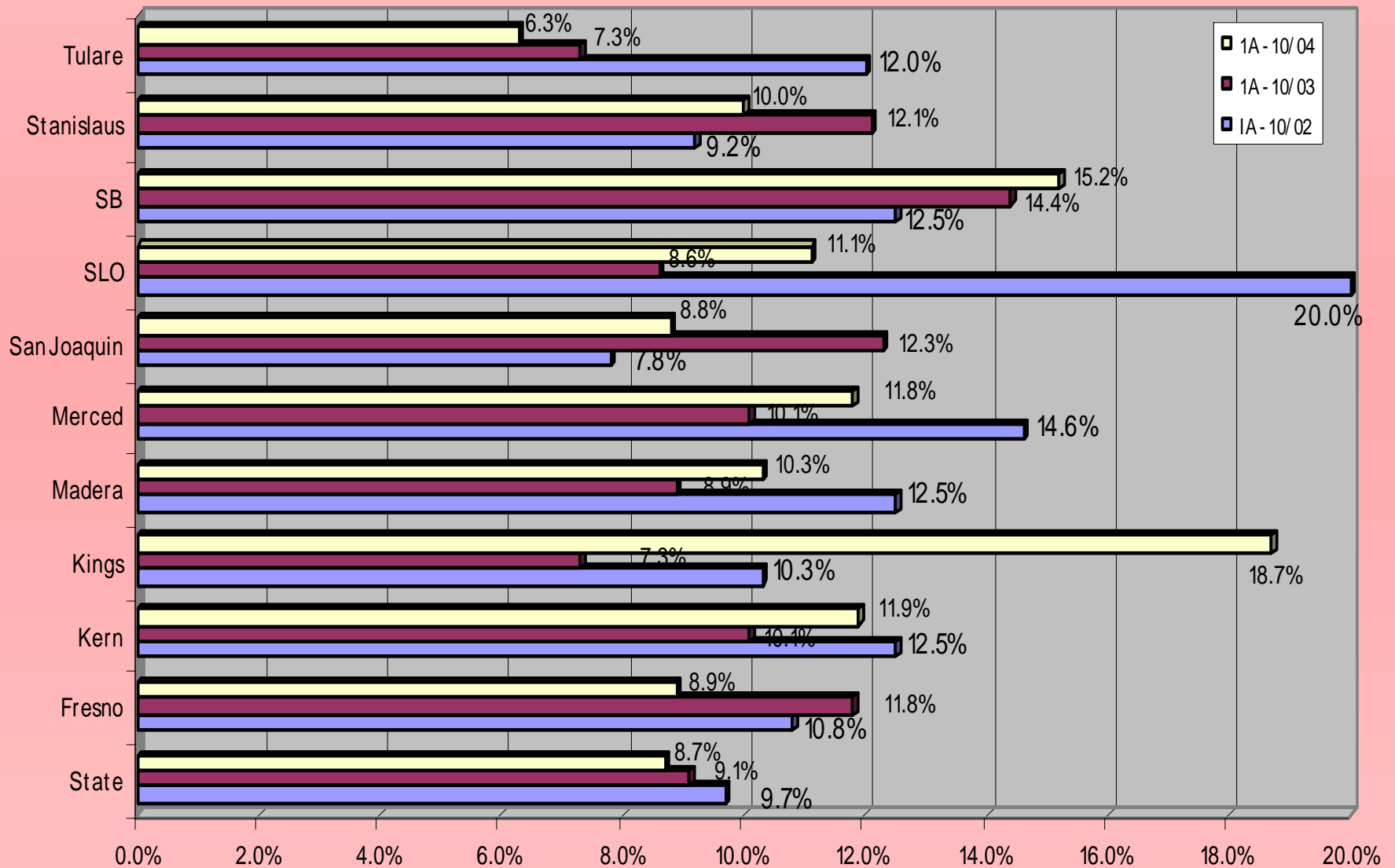

## Recurrence of Maltreatment - 1A - Federal Measure

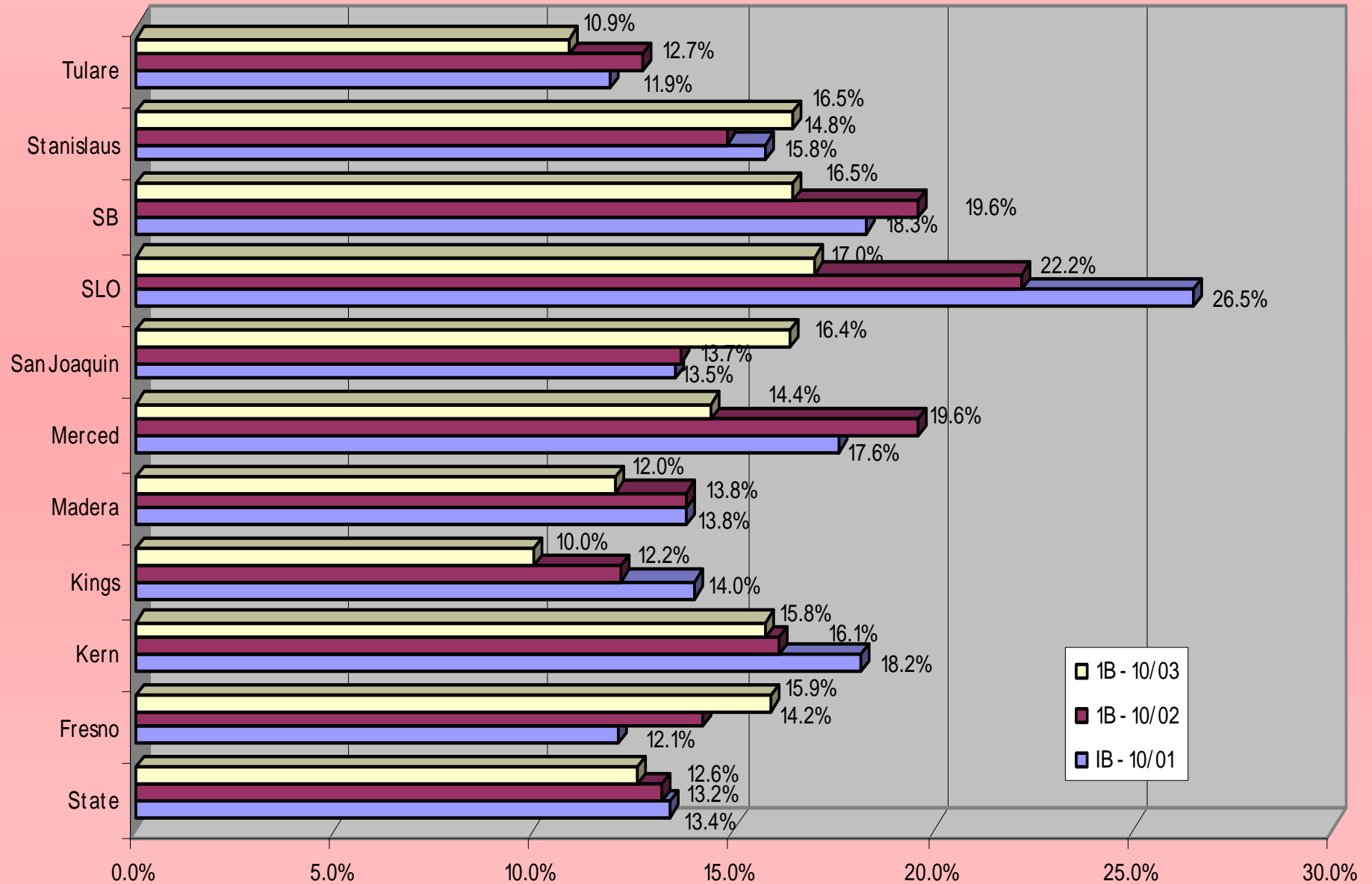

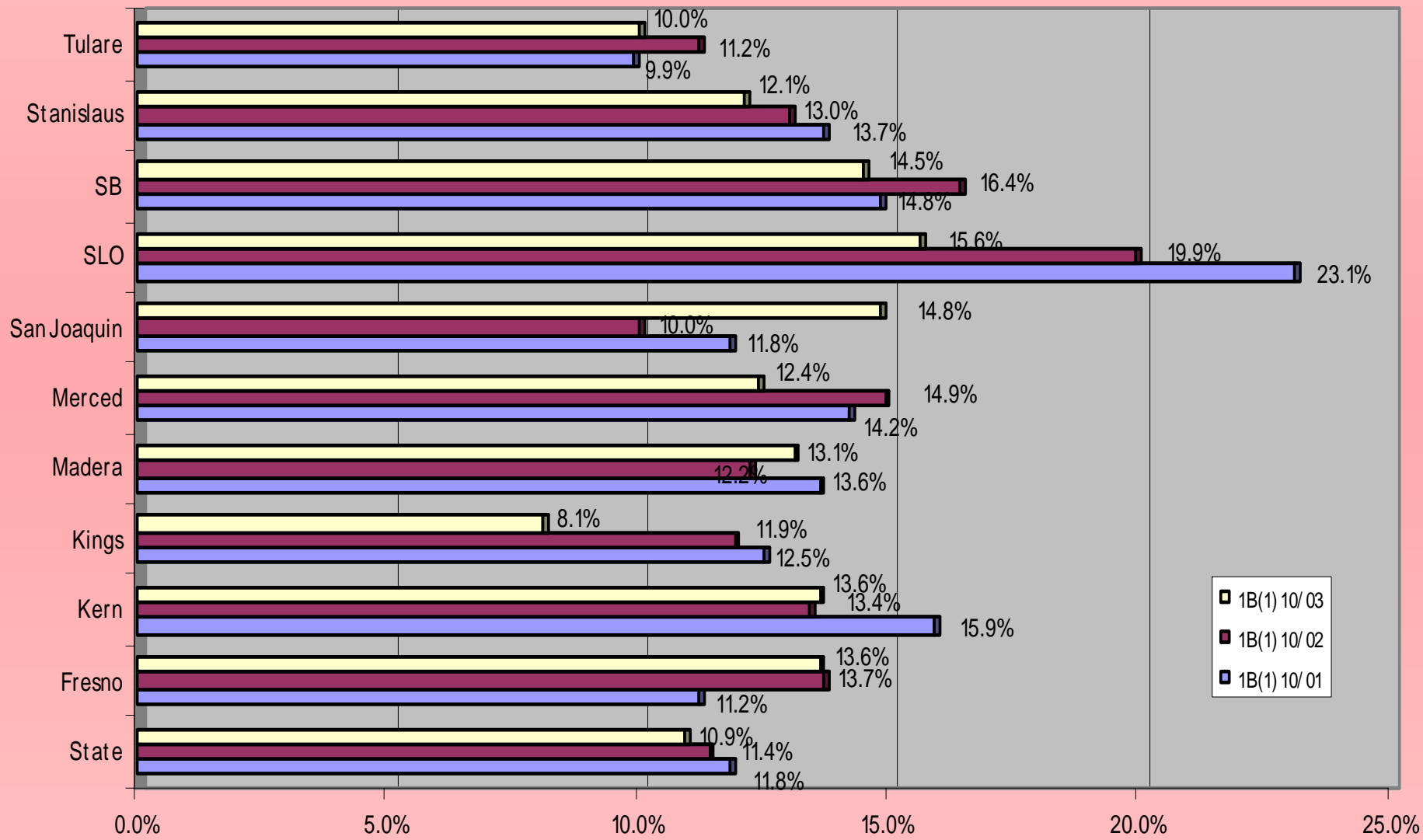
### Recurrence of Maltreatment - 1B - State Measure

(10/1/03-9/30/04 - most recent), what percent had a subsequent referral within 12 mos?

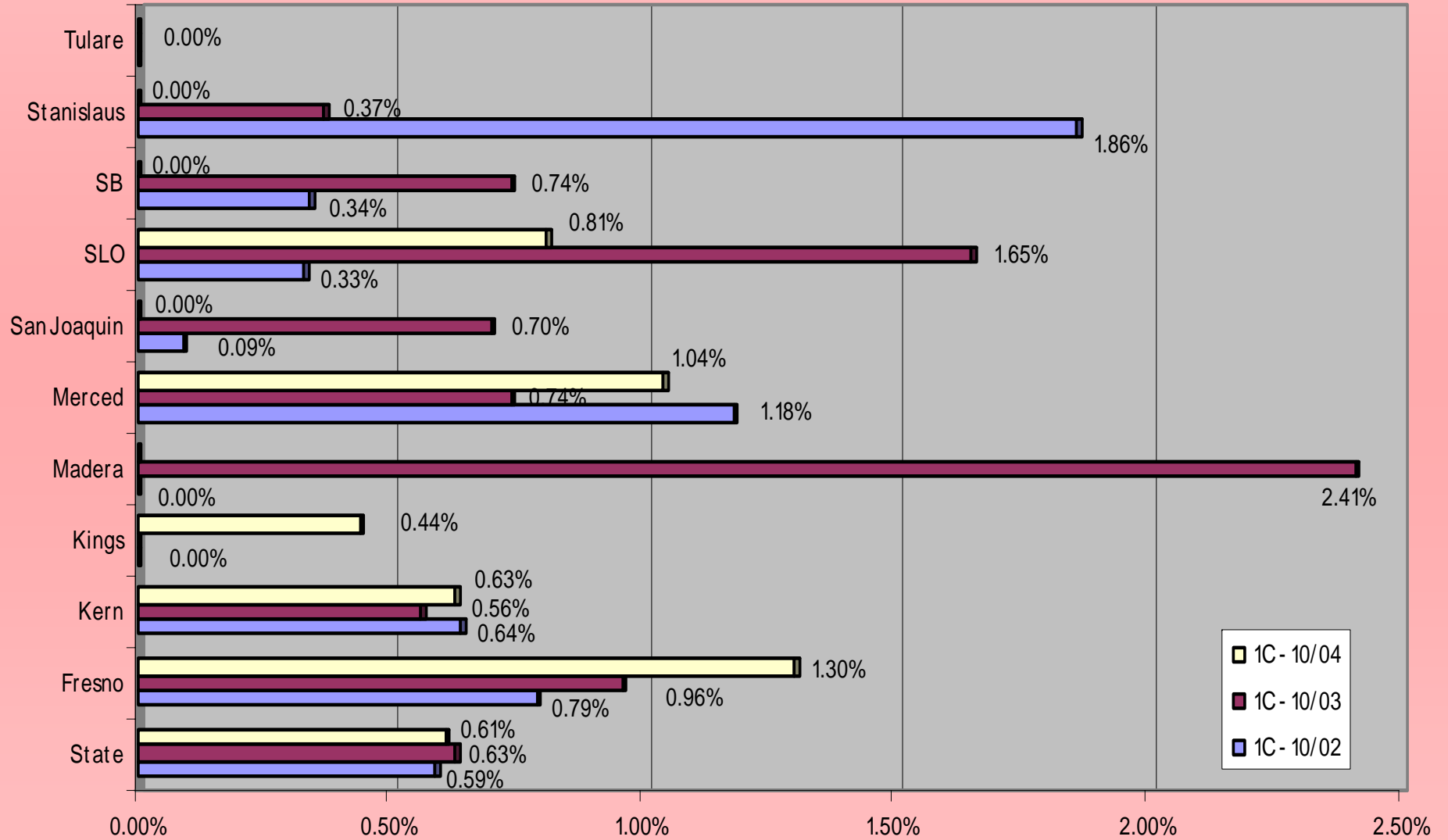


### Recurrence of Maltreatment 1B - State Measure

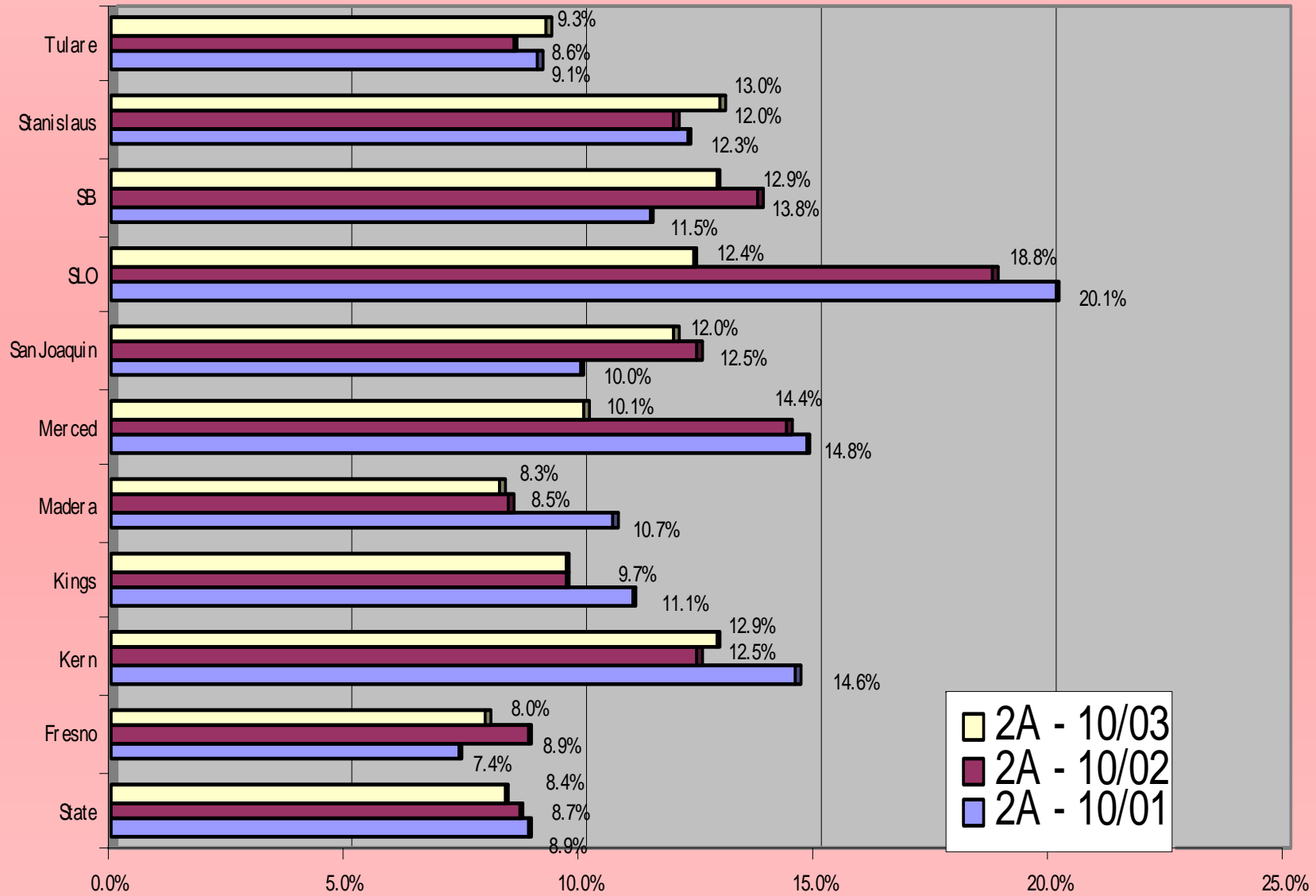
Of all children with a *First* substantiated referral during the 12 month study period - (10/1/03-9/30/04), what percent had a subsequent referral within 12 mos?



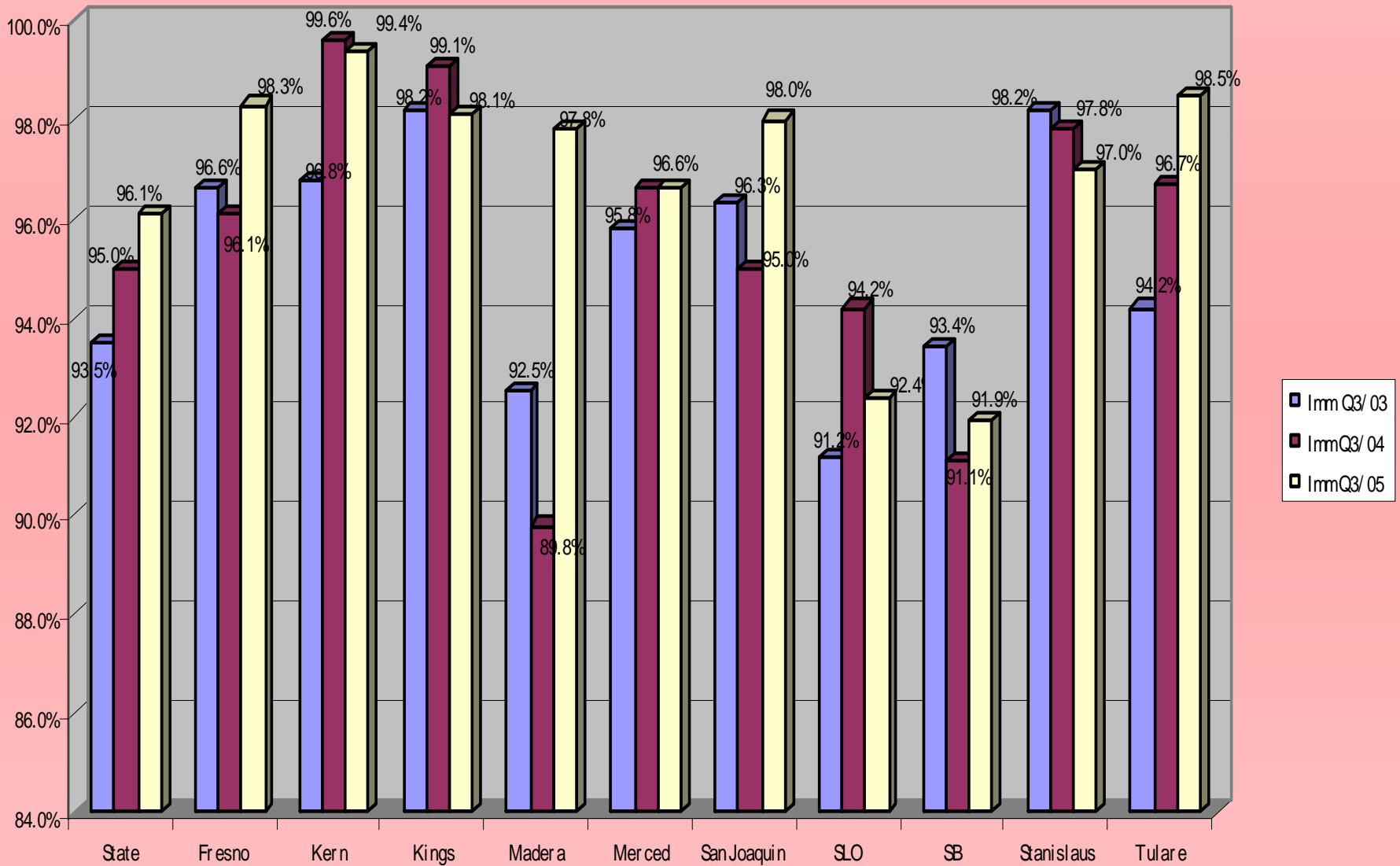
## 1C - Rate of Child Abuse/Neglect in Foster Care - Federal Measure 10/1/04-6/30/05 (most recent)



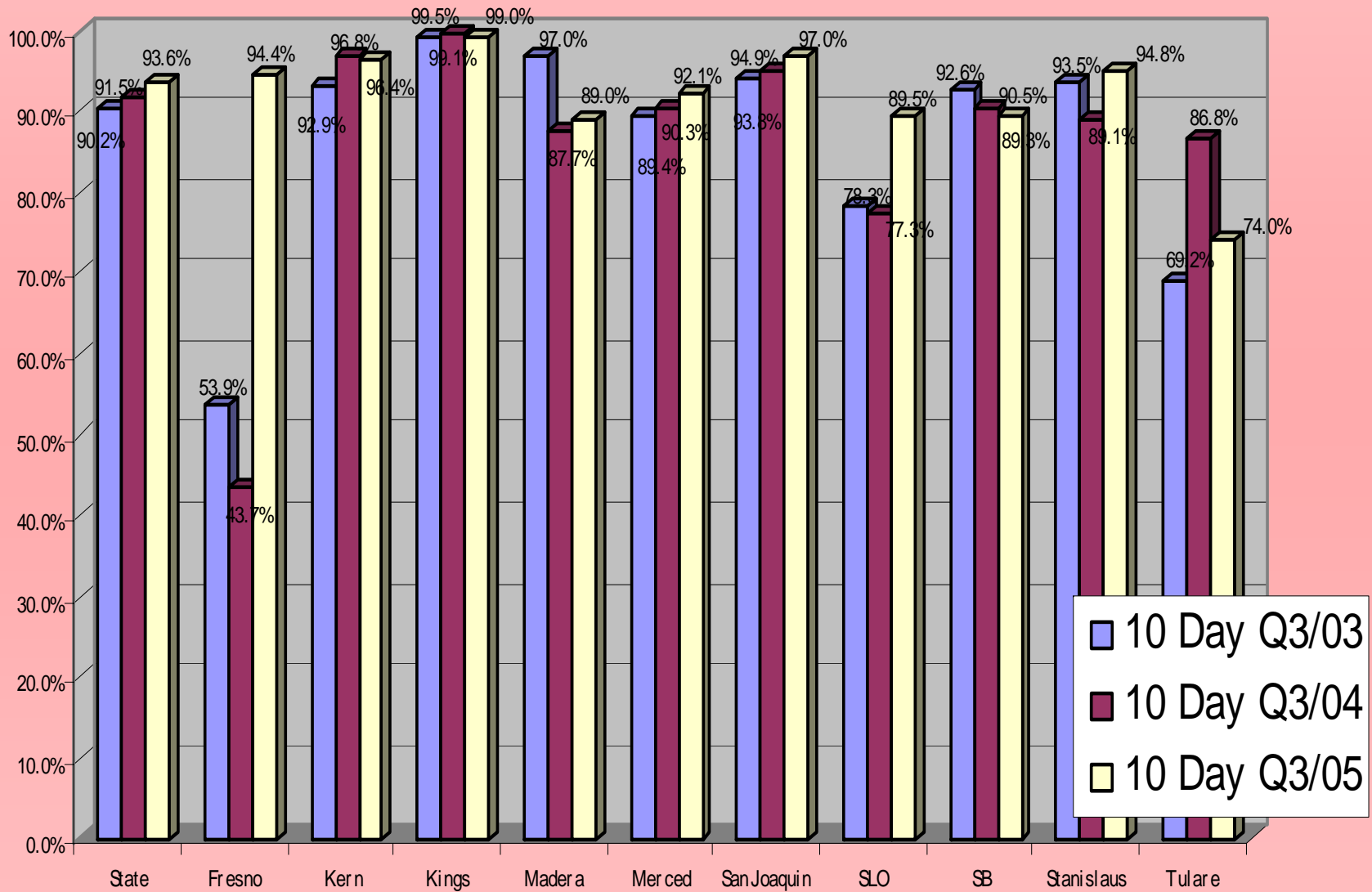
**Rate of Recurrence of Abuse/Neglect in Homes Where Children Were Not Removed  
2A - State Measure - Cohort Year 10/1/03 - 9/30/04**



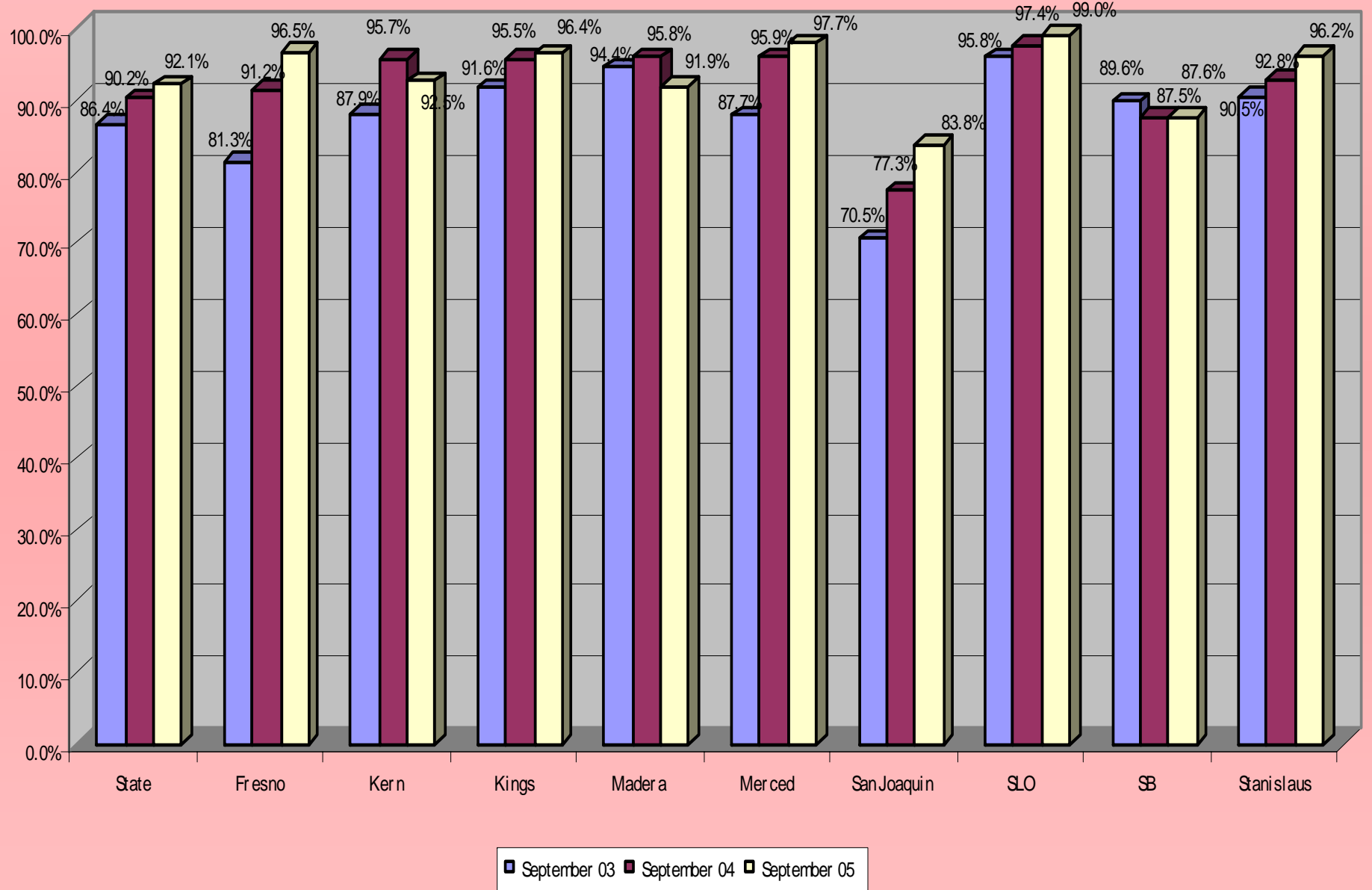
## Percent of Child Abuse/Neglect Referrals with a Timely Response 2B - State Measure - Immediate Response

## Timely Social Worker Visits With Child - 2C State Measure

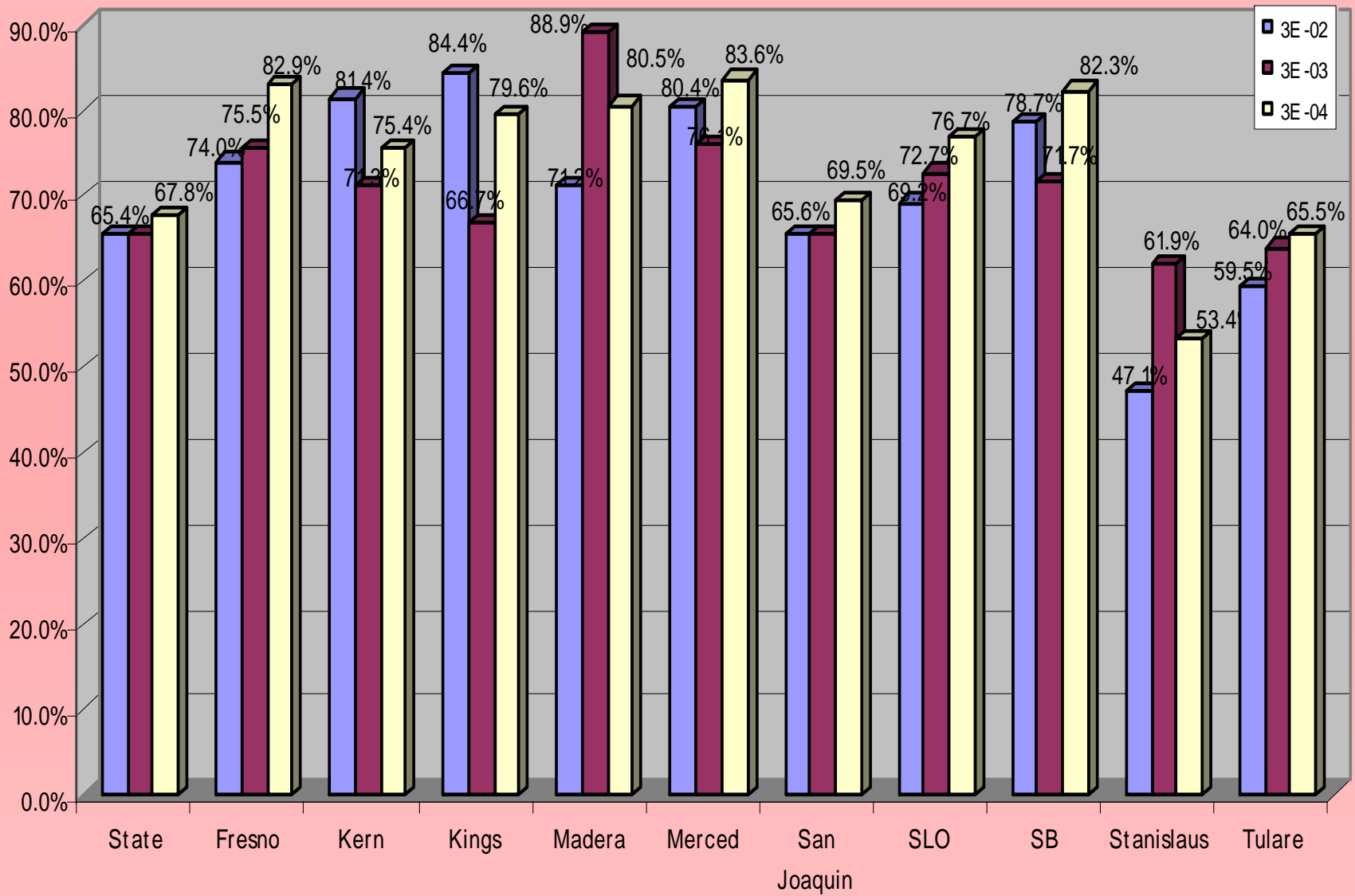

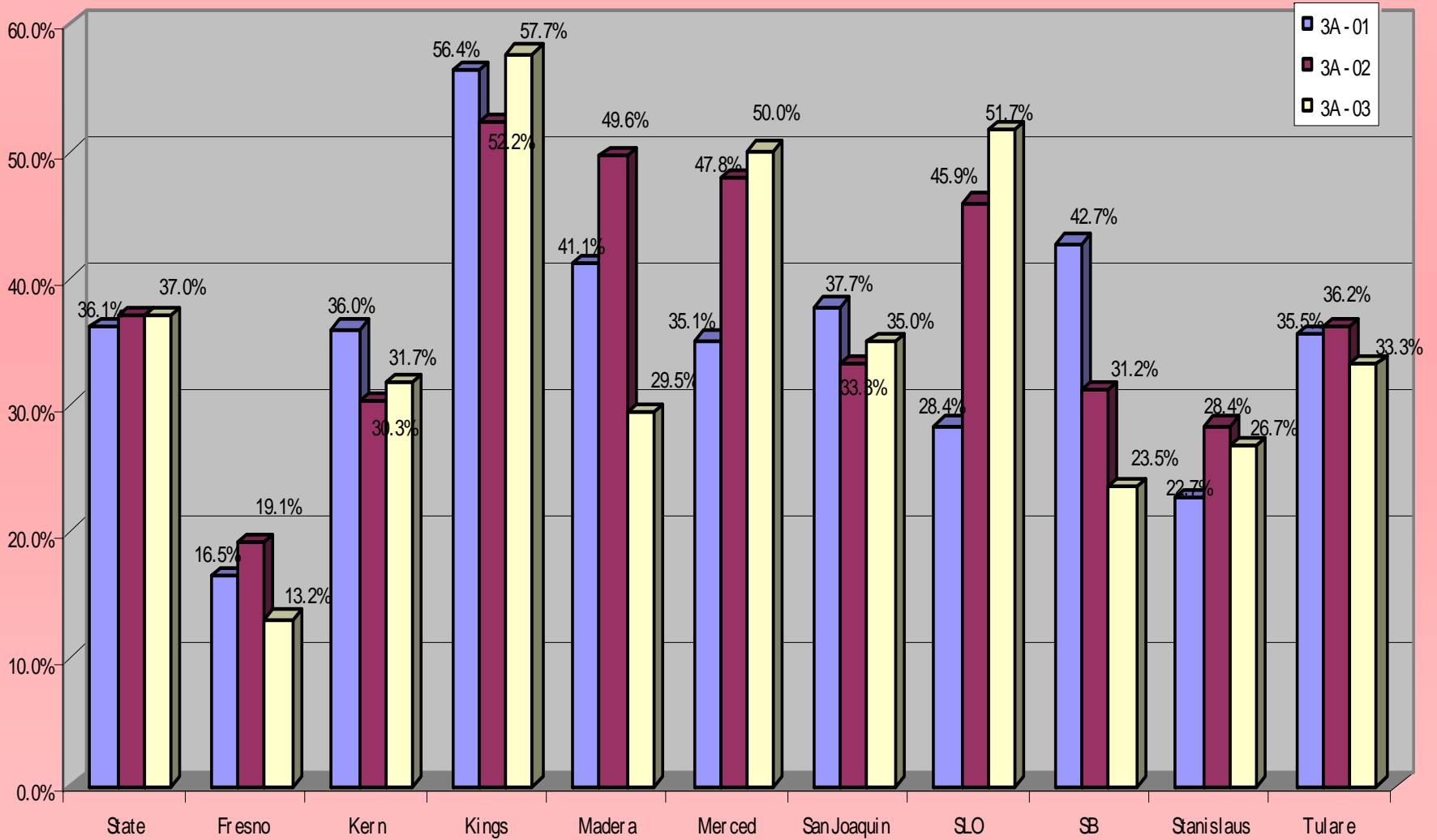

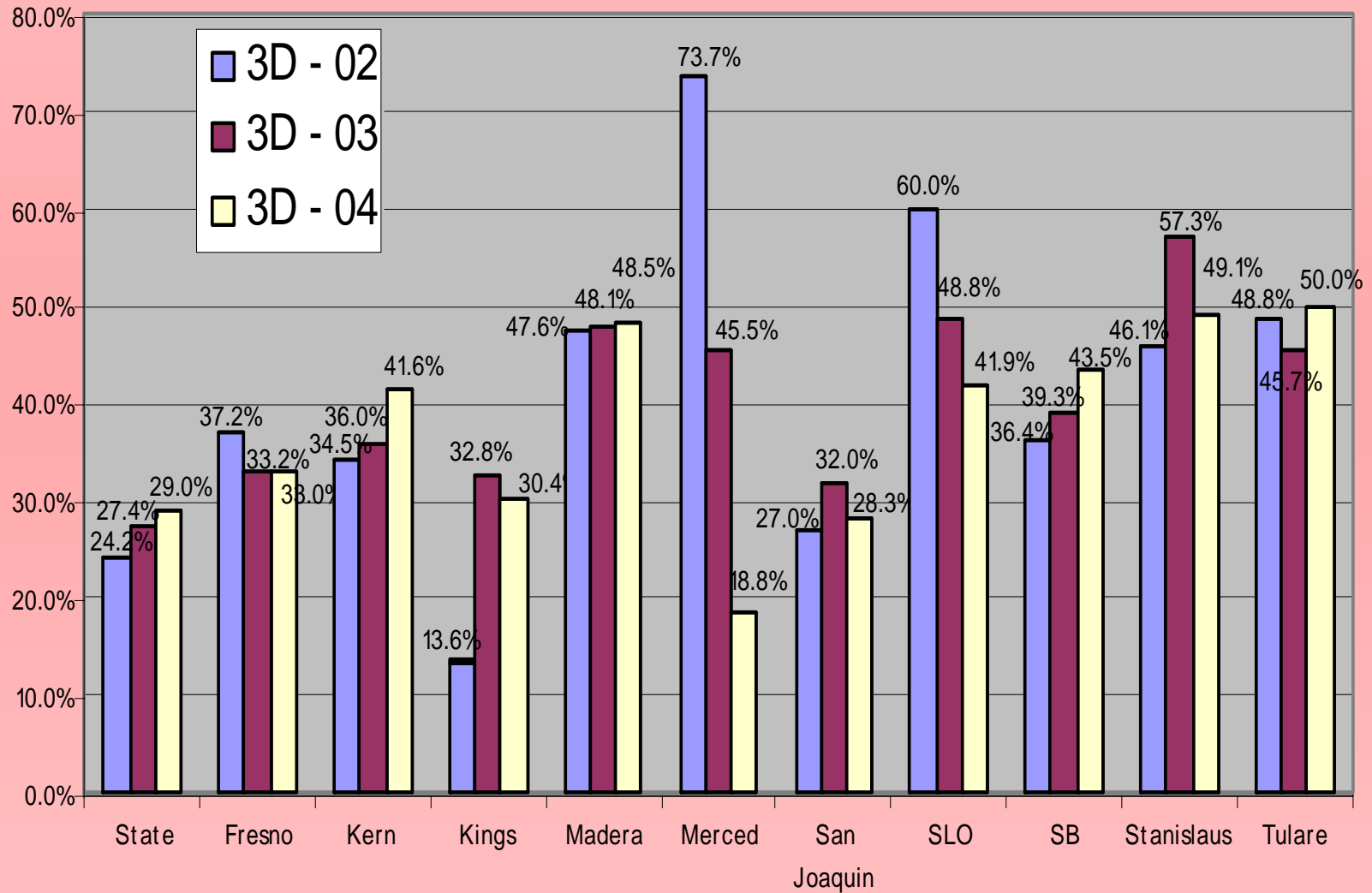
**Length of Time to Exit FC to Reunification 3E - Federal Measure**  
**Of children reunified during study period 7/1/04 - 6/30/05, this % had been in care for less than 12 months.**



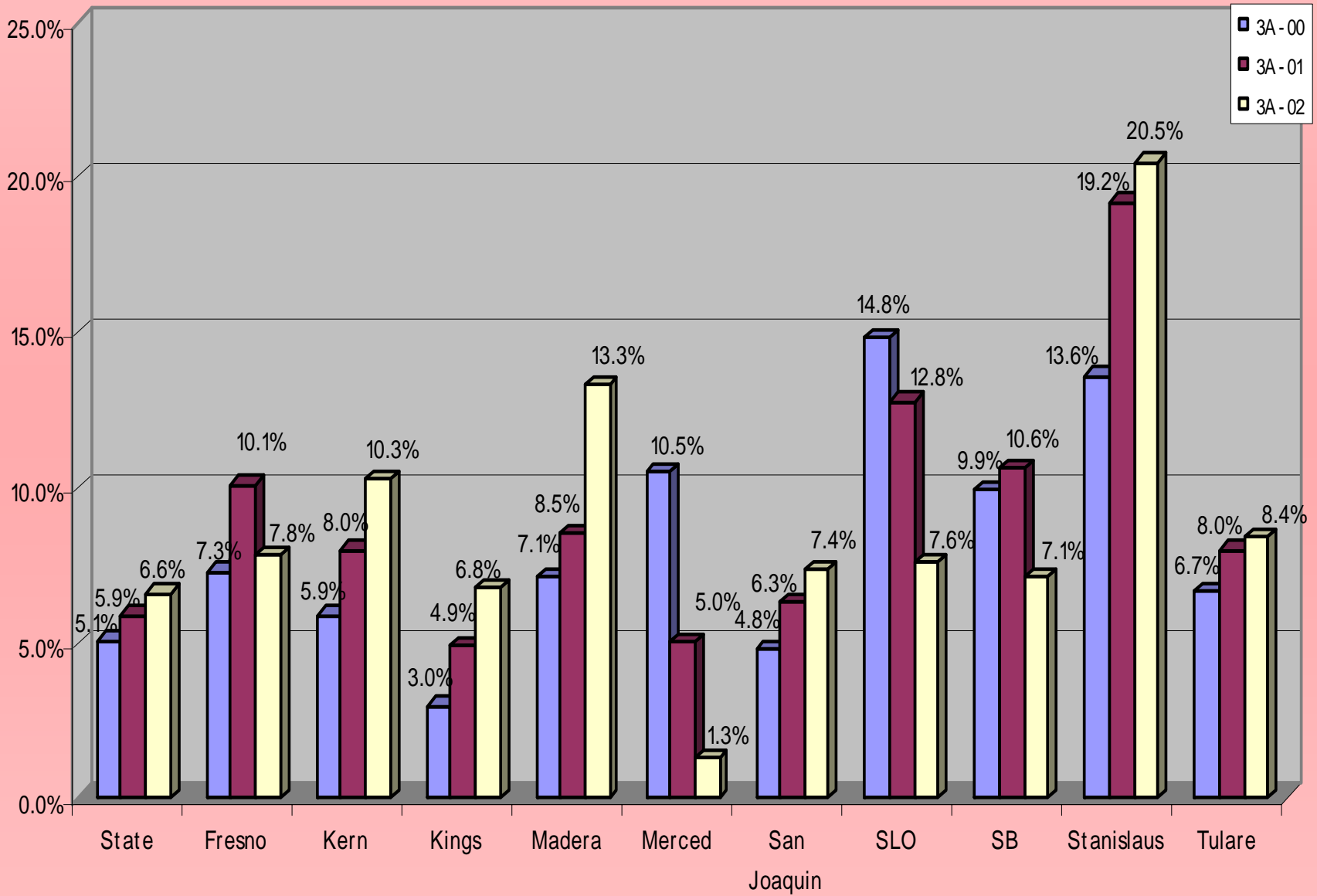
**Length of Time to Exit FC to Reunification - 3A - State Measure**  
**Children entering FC for first time during 7/1/03 - 6/30/04, the % reunified within 12 months.**



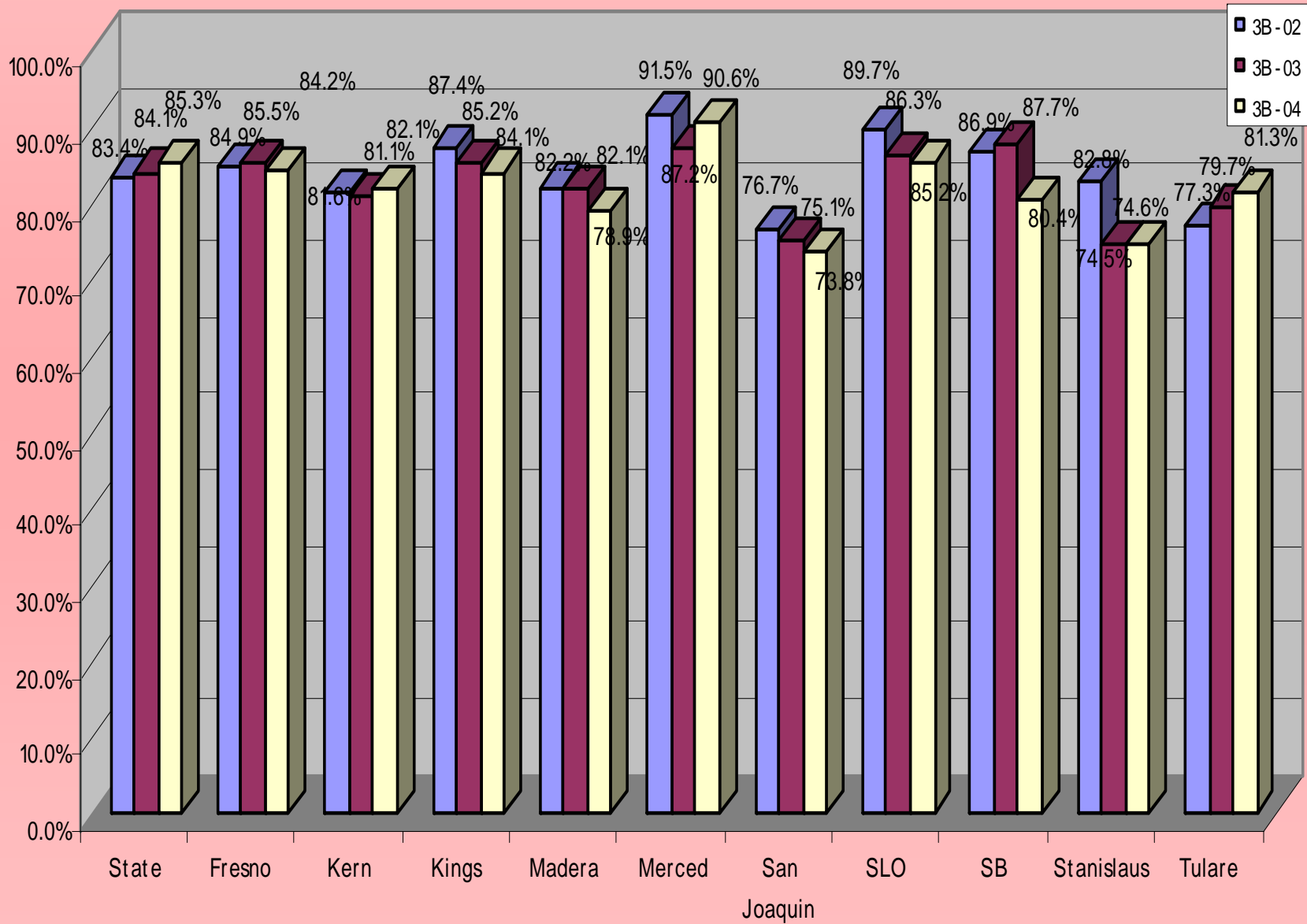
**Length of Time to Exit FC to Adoption - 3D - Federal**

**care for less than 24 months.**



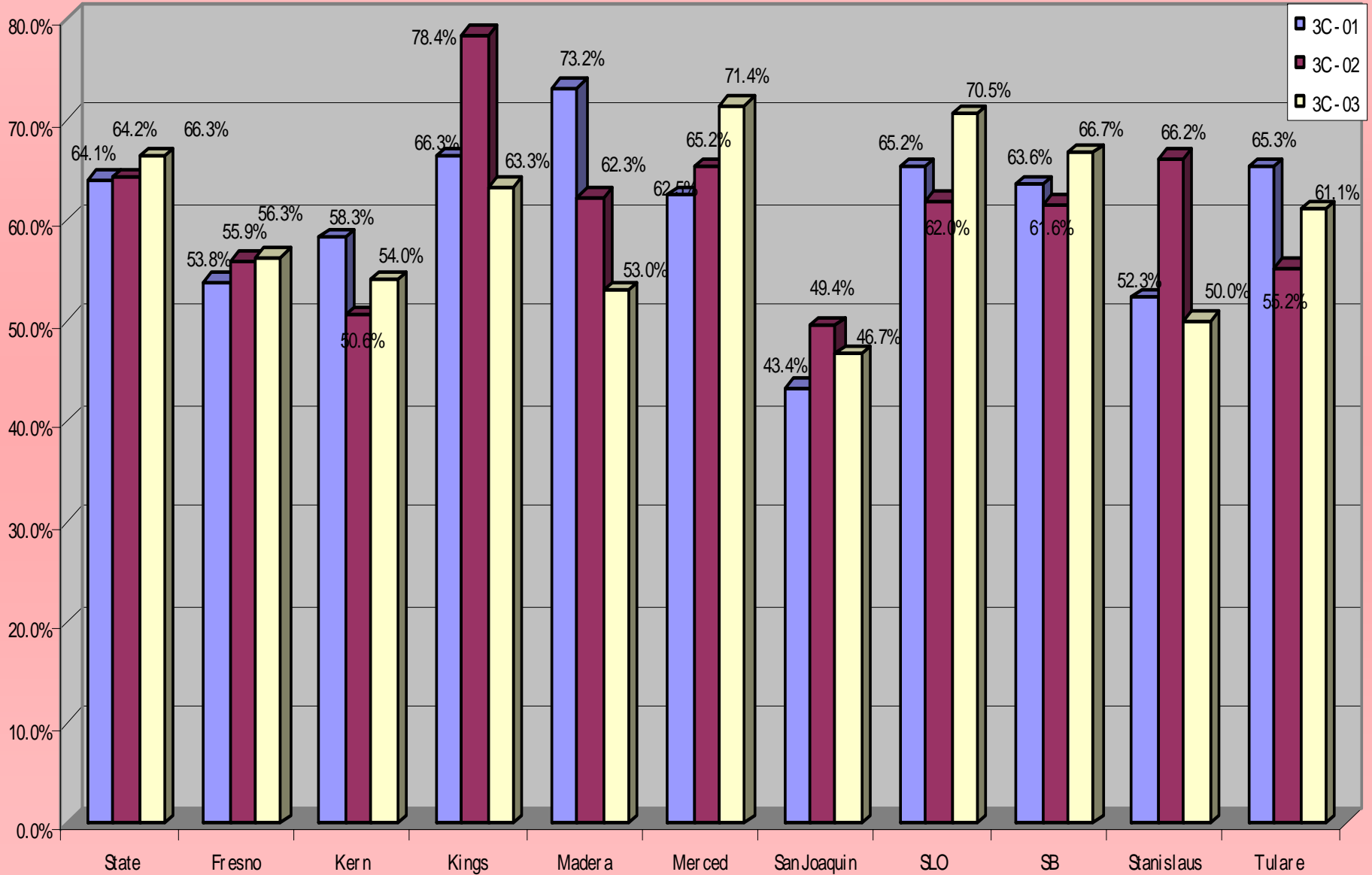
**Length of Time to Exit FC to Adoption - 3A - State Children entering FC for first time during 7/1/02- 6/30/03, the % reunified within 24 months.**

**Children in FC less than 12 months during study period 7/1/04 - 6/30/05, the % that had no more than 2 placements.**

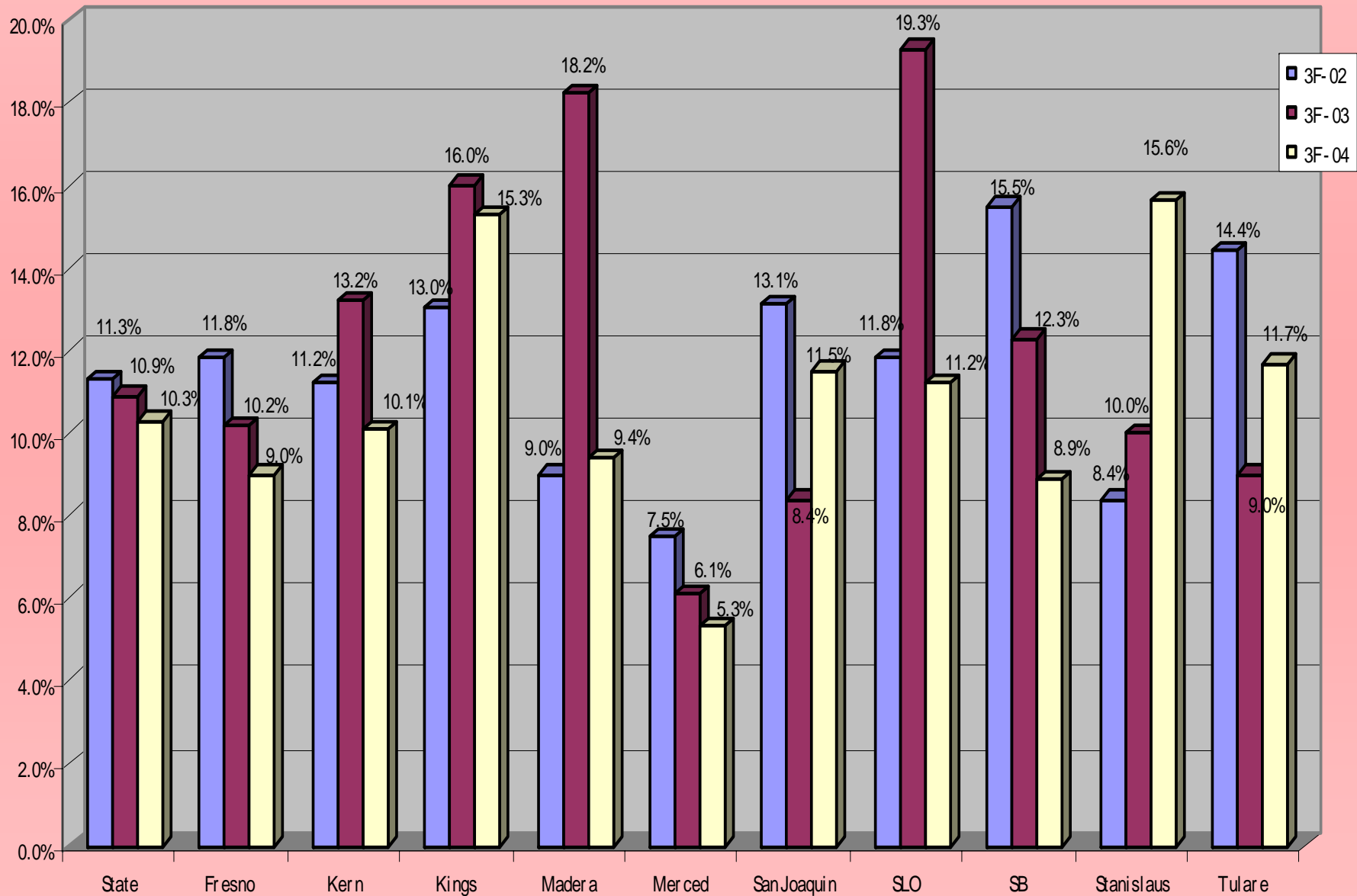


**Multiple Placements - 3C - State Measure**  
**Children entering FC for the first time during 7/1/03 - 6/30/04, and were in care for 12 months, the % that had no more than 2 placements.**



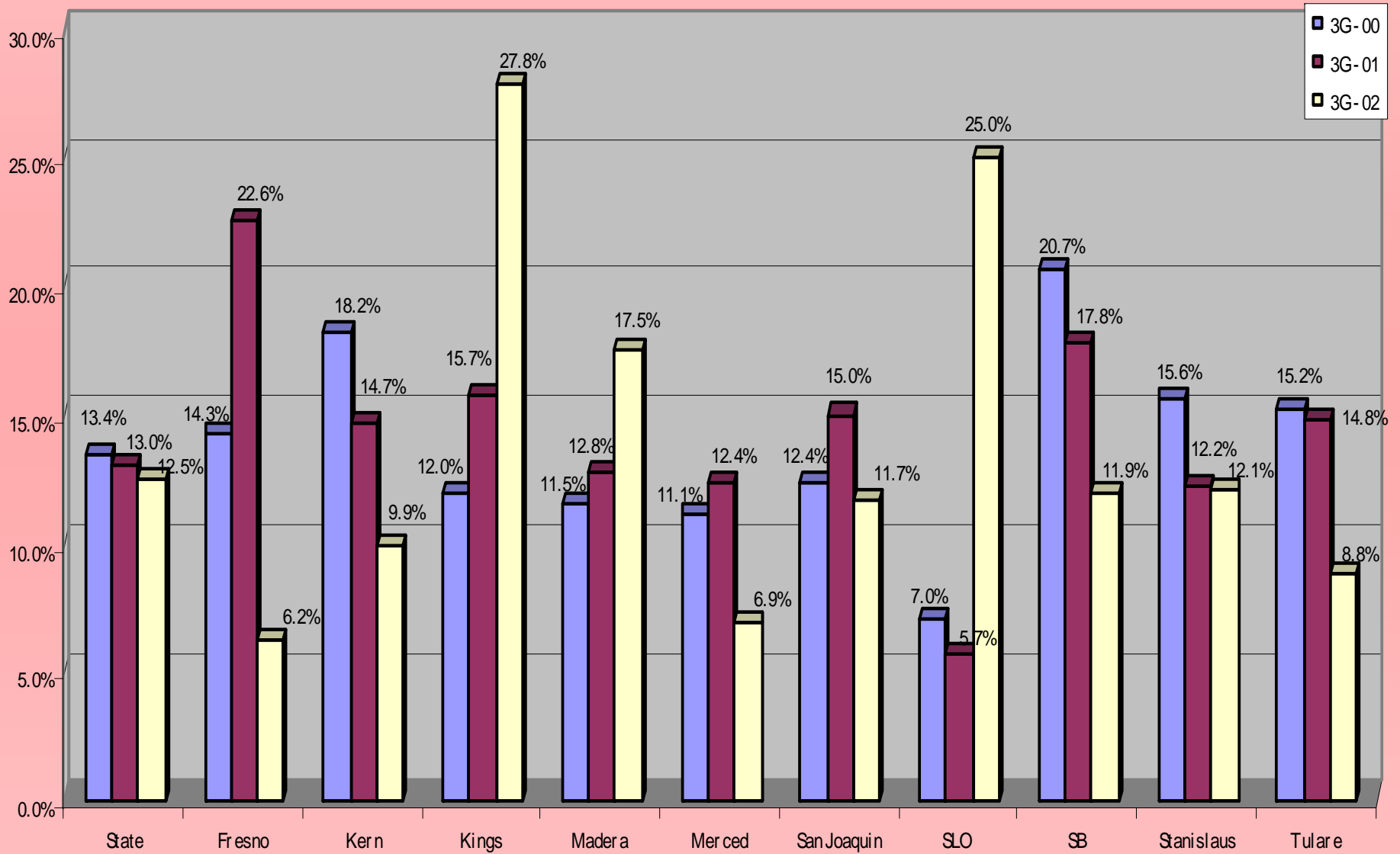
## Rate of Re-entry - 3F - Federal Measure

Children entering FC for the first time during 7/1/02 - 6/30/03, and were in care for 12 months, the % that re-entered FC within 12 months of reunification.

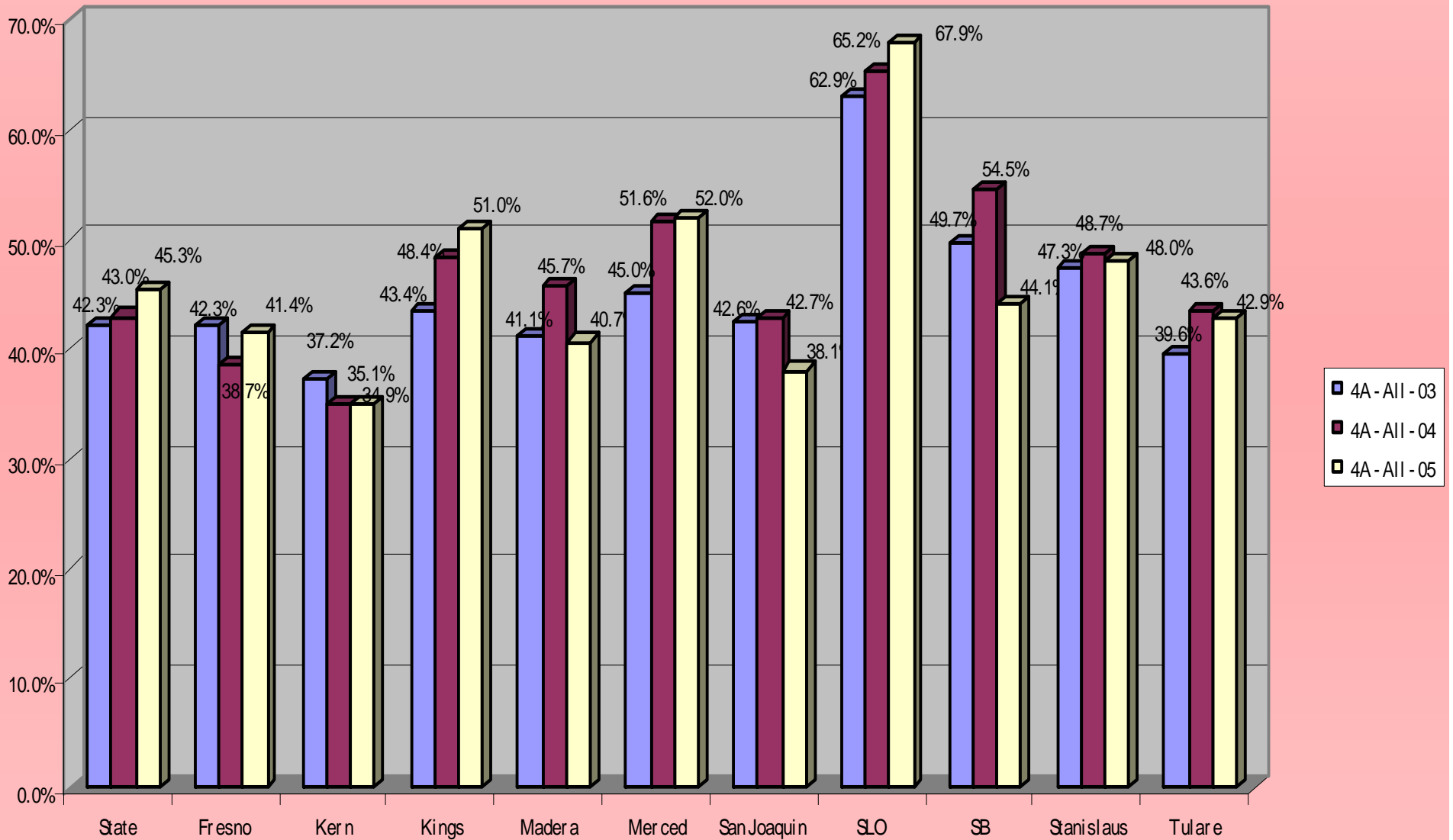




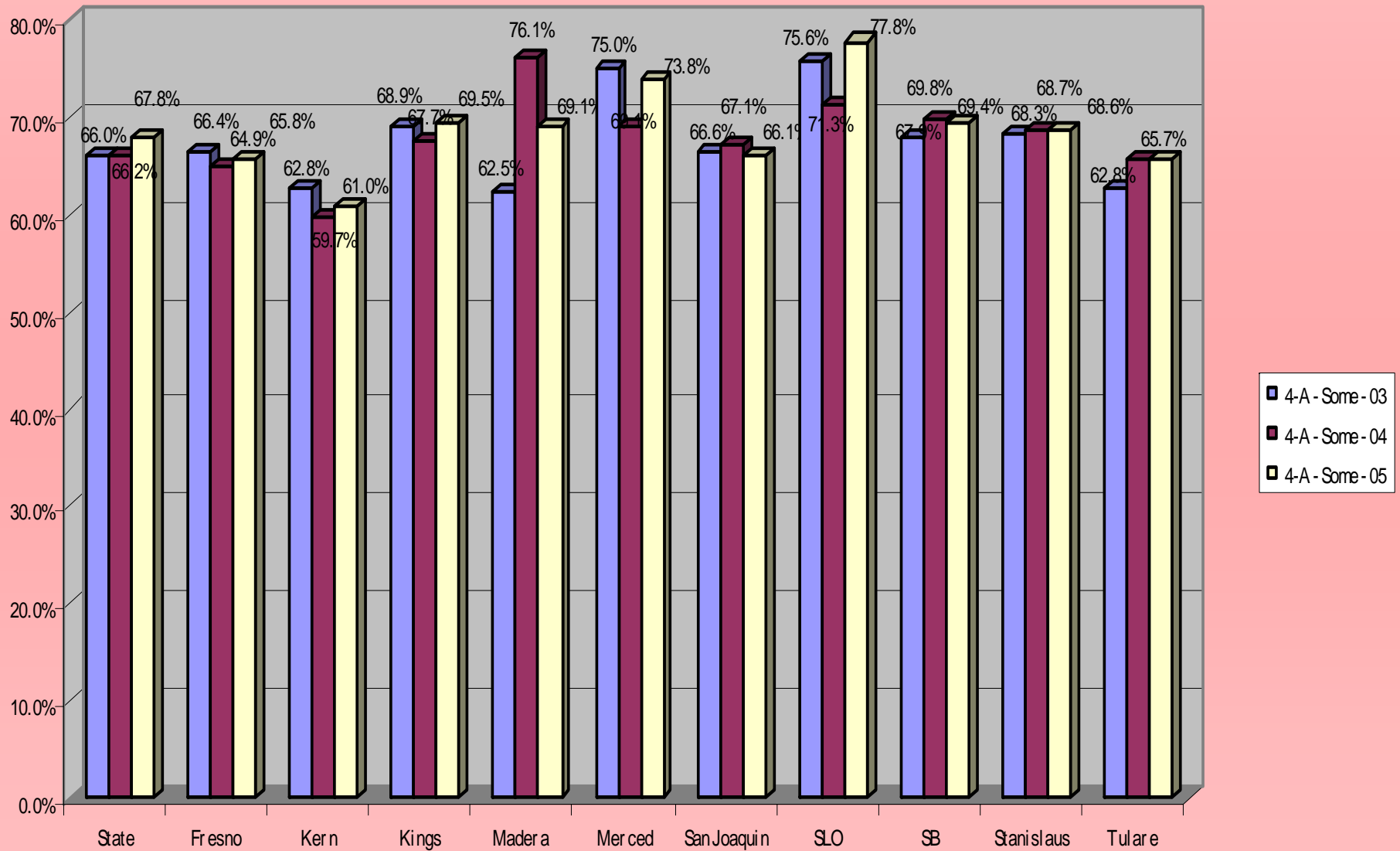

**For all children in FC on 10/1/05, the % placed with all of their siblings**



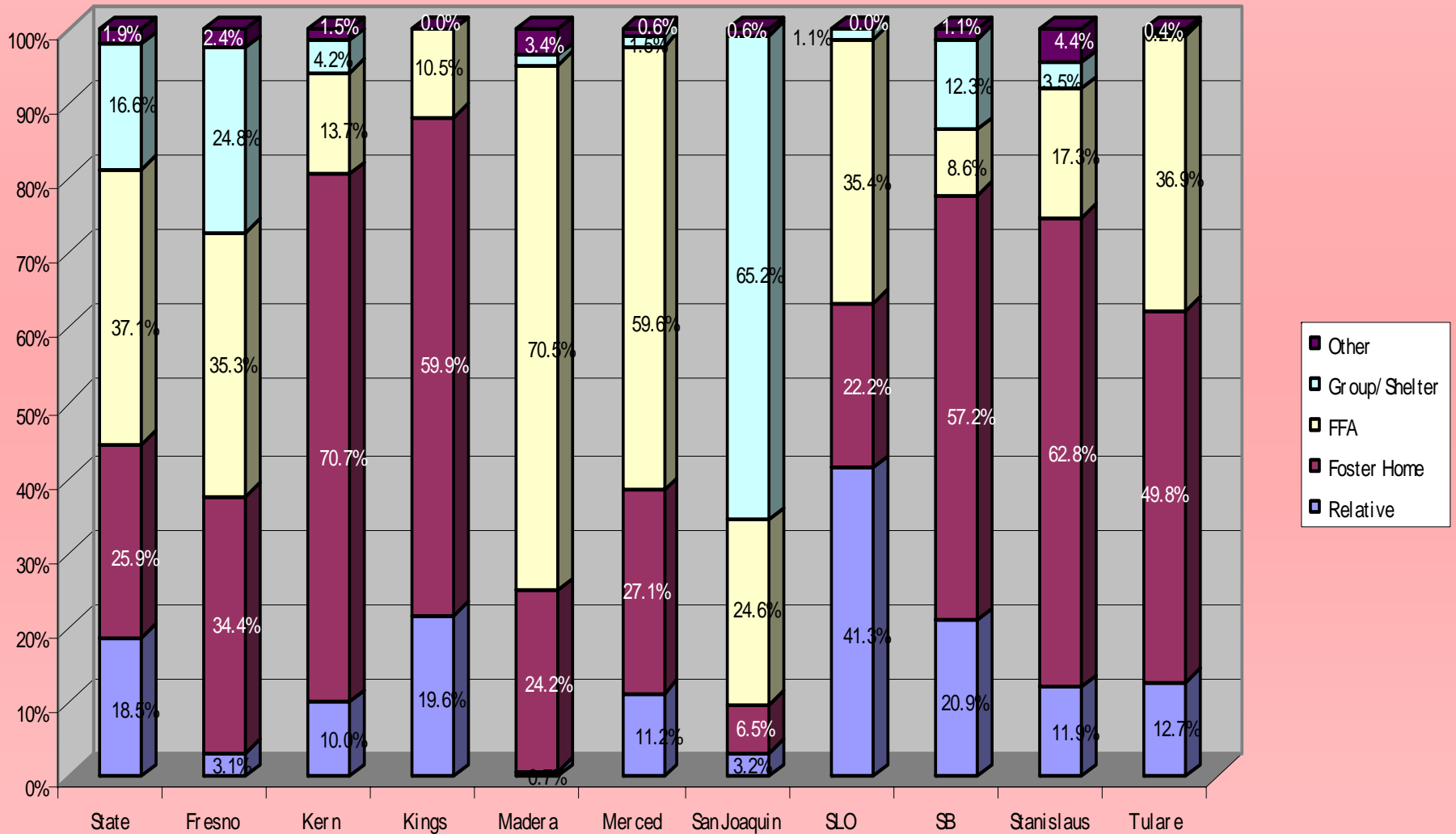
**Siblings Placed Together in Foster Care - 4 A State Measure**

## FC Placement in Least Restrictive Settings - 4B - State Measure

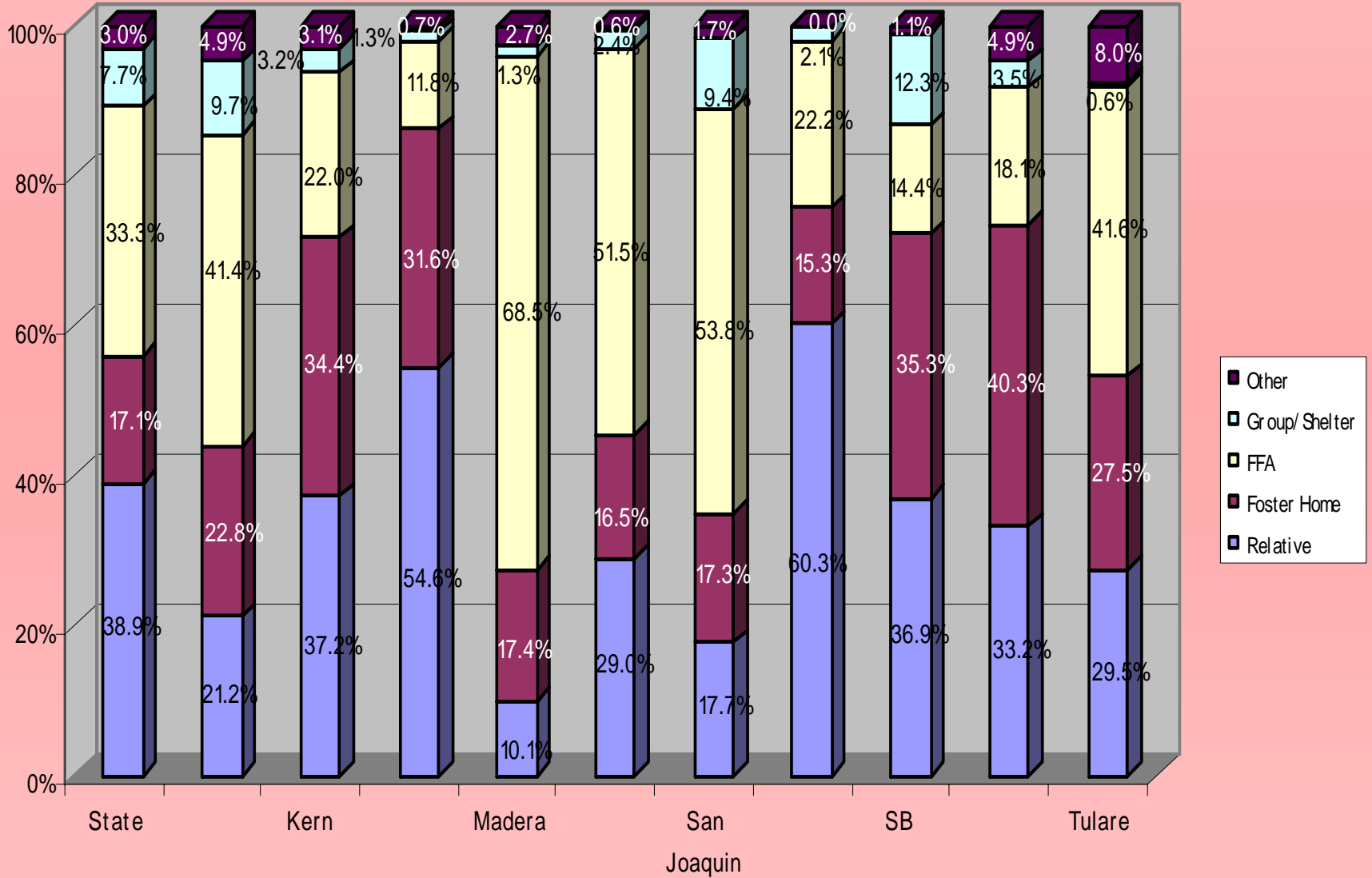
### Initial Placement

Children entering FC for the first time - 7/1/04 - 6/30/05 - the first placement type.

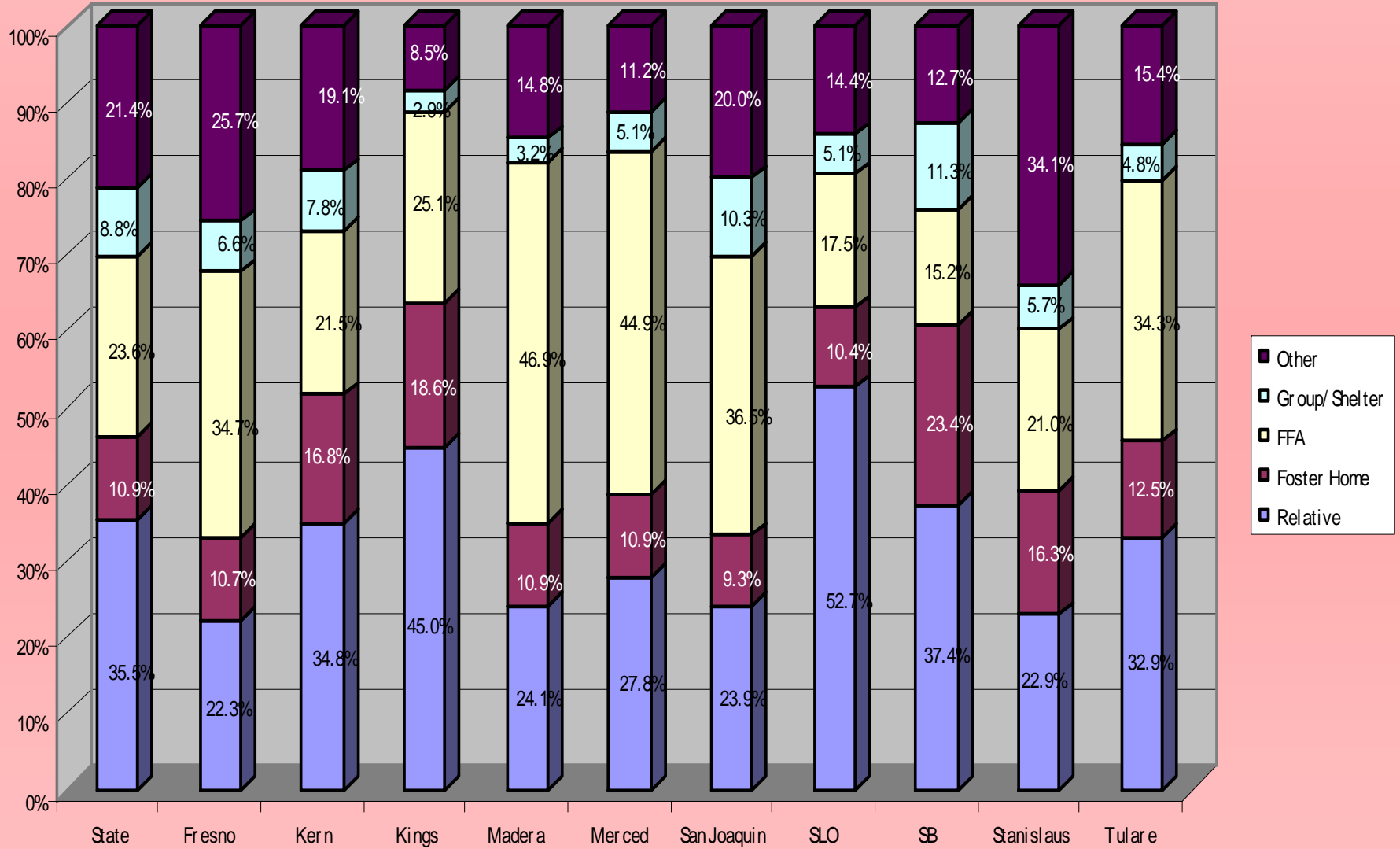


## FC Placement in Least Restrictive Settings - 4B - State Measure Primary Placement

Children entering FC for the first time - 7/1/04 - 6/30/05 - the predominant placement type.

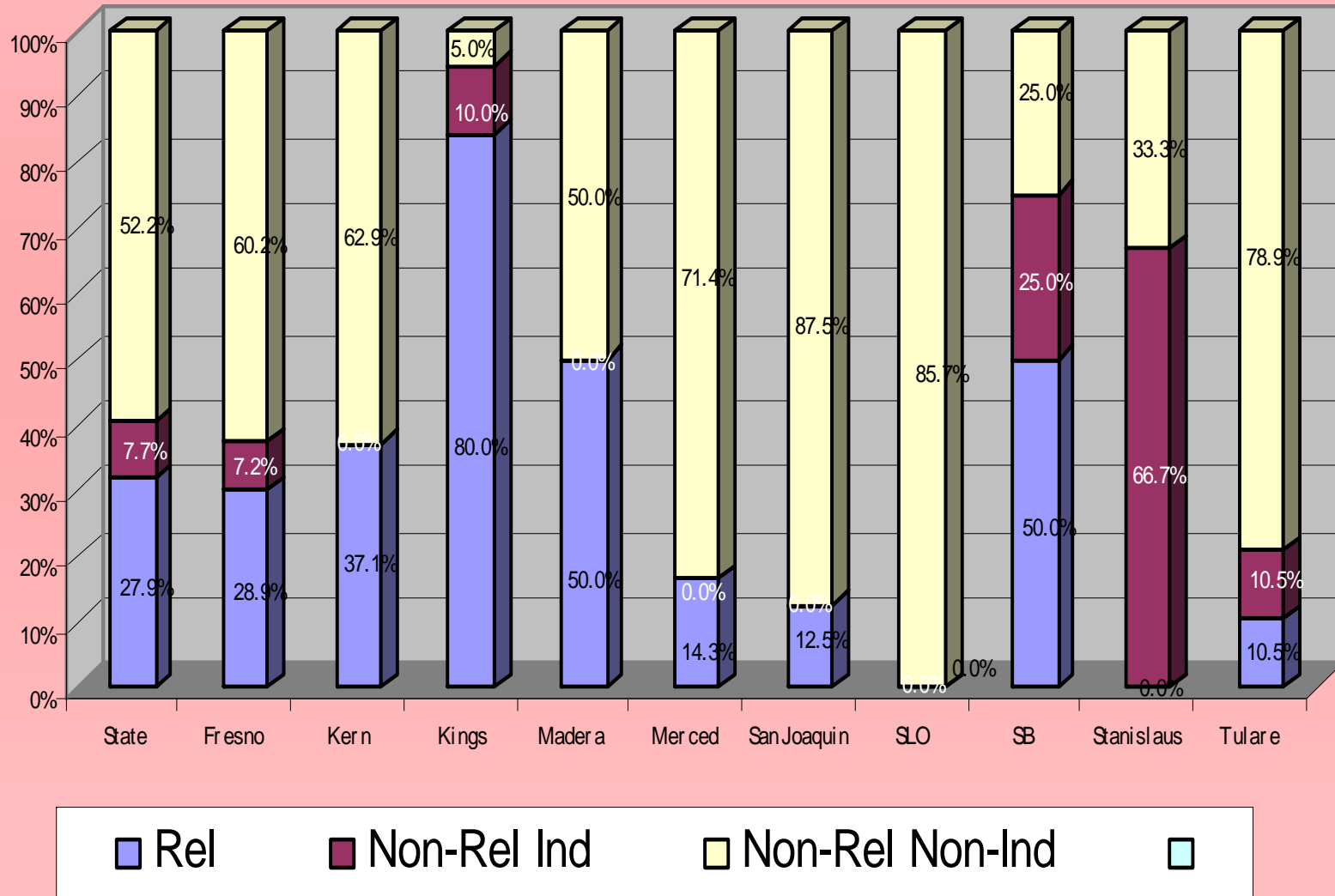


**FC Placement in Least Restrictive Settings - 4B - State Measure  
Point in Time Placement - 10/1/05**

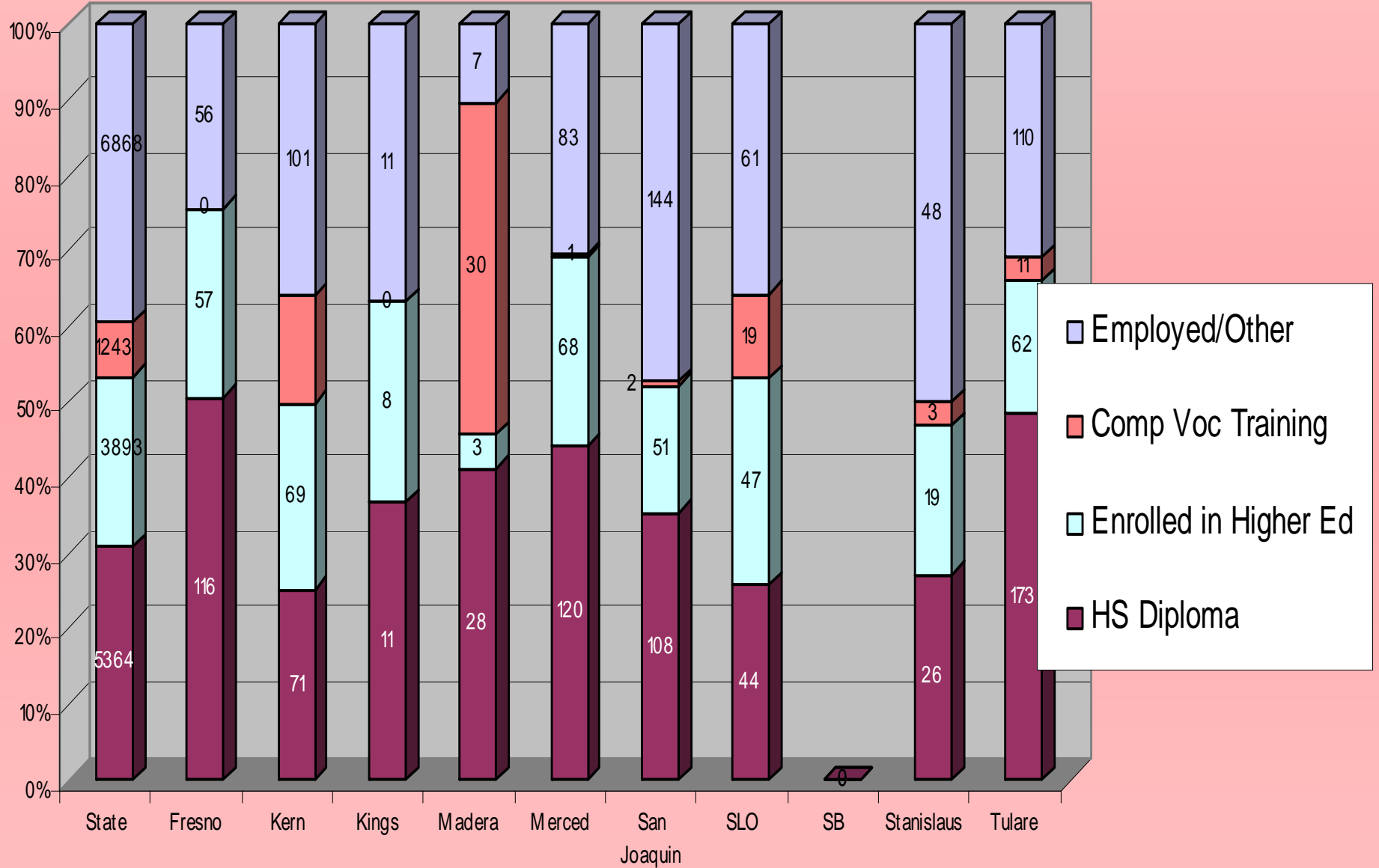


### Rate of ICWA Placement Preferences - 4E - State Measure
