<b>Ia. Getting Calm Together</b> (by 3 months)						
<b>These functions are built upon the capacity to be calm together</b>						
<b>Ib. When <i>calm</i>, able to make eye contact</b> (by 3 months)						
<b>II. When making <i>eye contact</i>, able to share joy</b> (by 5 months)						
<b>III. When sharing <i>joy</i>, able to create a continuous back and forth flow of communication</b> (by 9 months)						
<b>IV. When in a flow, able to expand <i>non-verbal communication</i> through an increasingly nuanced ability to read emotional cues, intentions, gestures, and to solve problems</b> (by 13 to 18 months)						
<b>TOP-DOWN</b>						
<b>V. When sharing <i>emotions</i>, able to create stories via symbolic play or pretend play with developing language skills</b> (by 24 to 36 months)						
<b>VI. When using emotional <i>stories</i>, able to make sense and solve problems together</b> (by 36 to 48 months)
