Rear Admiral (RADM) Nadine Simons is a nurse officer in the Commissioned Corps of the US Public Health Service and was appointed Regional Health Administrator (RHA) in April 2011. Prior to this appointment, she served as Deputy RHA for seven years and as the regional program consultant for the Office of Population Affairs for five years.
