### Prerequisites:

1. Must be eligible for admission to the University.
2. Eligibility for admission to the RN to BSN Nursing major:
  - Current, valid California RN license
  - Graduation from an associate degree program in nursing
  - Completion of all prerequisite courses with minimum "C" grade
  - Currently enrolled at Fresno State/admitted university applicant at time of nursing program entry
  - Before taking clinical course, students must have clearance from the Student Health Center
