University Dining Hall, California State University, Fresno

Coming from the north: Take Hwy 99 south to the Herndon exit. Take Herndon Avenue east to Cedar Avenue. Turn right (south) on Cedar to Shaw Avenue. Make a U-turn at the light and head north on Cedar, making a right hand turn onto Scott Avenue (first turn after intersection). [Parking lot P27 will be on your right \(parking is free\)](#). The University Dining Hall is located just to the northeast of the parking lot.

Coming from the south: Take Hwy 99 to the Hwy 41 north exit. On Hwy 41 north, exit east on Hwy 180. On Hwy 180 east, exit east on Hwy 168. On Hwy 168 east, exit on Shaw Avenue. Turn left (west) on Shaw Avenue to Cedar Avenue. Turn right (north) on Cedar Avenue to Scott Avenue. Turn right onto Scott Avenue first turn after intersection). [Parking lot P27 will be on your right \(parking is free\)](#). The University Dining Hall is located just to the northeast of the parking lot.
