BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SUPERVISOR

Responsible for providing clinical supervision of behavioral health clinicians working in the Learning about Parenting (LAP) and Infant Family Programs (IFP) to insure appropriate care and fidelity to the program model. Supervisor may also provide short-term treatment to various populations including drug-exposed, developmentally delayed, trauma-affected (depression, anxiety, substance abuse, etc.) infants, children and adults that present with developmental, social/emotional, and behavioral challenges. Provide consultation, training and support to EPU staff as needed. Works with multidisciplinary team (LAP, Home Visitors, Early Childhood Specialist, Program Manager, DSS social worker, etc.) in developing and implementing family centered care plans and interventions. Participate in program evaluation.

Qualifications:

Education: Must hold a Master Degree in social work, marriage and family therapy or related field or a Doctoral degree in clinical or counseling psychology. Must be licensed to practice in the State of California.

Experience:

- 2+ years' experience working as part of a multidisciplinary team in assessing; developing and implementing behavior &/or mental health care plans; facilitate workshops; and treating young children with developmental, social/emotional, behavioral, and mental health challenges and their parents.
- Must have a strong academic and clinical grounding in family systems and child development.
- Must hold valid California Driver's license and good driving record with no serious violations for the previous two-year period and be able to provide proof of current automobile liability insurance.
- Bi-lingual in Spanish is a plus.
- Computer literate, knowledge of Microsoft Office products.
