Position Description:

This position will provide weekly group and monthly individual supervision to 12-15 MFTIs and ACSWs as required by the BBS for licensure. The Clinical Supervisor will serve as a Consultant to the agency and provide consultation to the Clinical Director on implementing policies and procedures that are in alignment with current laws, practices and trends. Additionally, this position will provide training to supervisees and other agency staff on topics related to social work, trauma informed care, etc. Applicants should be well versed in legal and ethical issues to ensure appropriate support for the agency is offered.

Some qualifications include:

- Must possess a current and valid California license BBS (LCSW) for at least two years prior to the commencement of supervision; this position supports both MFTI and ACSW levels-so the candidate must have a valid LCSW license.
- Practiced psychotherapy or directly supervised trainees, interns, or associate clinical social workers who perform psychotherapy as part of their clinical practice in two of the past five years immediately preceding the commencement of supervision.
- Clinical supervisor needed to provide supervision and consultation to MFTIs and ACSWs at the Child Abuse Prevention Council of San Joaquin County.
- Must meet all BBS requirements to act as Clinical Supervisor for trainees/interns
- Employed as Independent Contractor - roughly 23 hours/month - including 4 hours/week of group supervision and 8 hours/month of individual supervision; flexible scheduling!
- Salary Negotiable
