

Dr. Sunantha Teyarachakul is a new Associate Professor for the Decision Sciences in the Department of Information Systems and Decision Sciences. She was an Assistant Professor of Management at MacEwan University in Edmonton, Canada since 2012. She also taught as an Assistant Professor at Mahidol University in Thailand (2011-2012), at ESSEC Business School in Paris, France (2008-2011), and at Minnesota State University Moorhead (2003-2008).
