

Errata for the article “Food and Beverage Manufacturing in Central California”, Pages 22-27.

1. The values in Table 1 (page 23) pertain to output and not to GDP. So, the readers are requested to substitute the term ‘GDP’ with ‘output’ in the body of the article. The title of the Table 1 should be read as “Food and Beverage Manufacturing Sectors Output in 2016 (Millions)”. Output is value of sales, whereas GDP is the value of sales less the cost of intermediate inputs used in production.
2. On page 27, in the first paragraph under Multiplier Effects, the number \$1.83 should be changed to \$1.22.
3. In the last sentence of the article on page 27, “... impact of the food and beverage manufacturing sector to the Central Valley may be over \$25 billion (\$21 billion in direct food/beverage manufacturing impact times the 1.22 economic multiplier),”.
4. The third author Dr. Patrick Berends has a PhD degree which was not printed in the final version.
