SOAP NOTES

Use the following guidelines in writing SOAP notes. (Hegde & Davis, 2010)

1.) Describe your impressions of the client in the <u>subjective</u> section. For example: The client appeared very alert and cooperative. He stated, "*I'm ready to work hard today*."

2.) Write measurable information in the <u>objective</u> section. For instance: *The client produced four syllable phrases with 80% accuracy in 40 out of 50 trials.* **[40/50]".**

3. Describe your <u>analysis</u> of the session in the assessment section. You may also compare the client's performance across sessions in this section. For example: [*a*] *Production for / r/ increased from 65% accuracy during the last session to 90 % accuracy during today's session. [b] Withdrawal of visual models resulted in a decrease in accurate production of single syllable words from 90% to 65%.*

4.) Outline the course of treatment in the <u>plan</u> section. You might simple state: [*a*] *Continue current treatment activities.* [*b*] *Continue training production of functional CVC words at the imitative level.*
