Terrie received one of the first degrees from Fresno State College in 1951 that led to a Medical Technician career. Terrie married Katsumi Tanino, a Mechanical Engineer, in 1953 and moved to Seattle, Washington.

Terrie began her career in 1953 as a microbiologist at the Seattle King County Health Department Laboratories. Her career spanned 40 + years. She retired in 1996, but remained “on call” for another year. From 1983 until her retirement she served as a supervisor and lead microbiologist for the following sections: Enteric; Food poisoning; Sexually-transmitted disease; Tuberculosis; and outbreaks of *Staphylococcus aureus*, Diphtheria, *Neisseria meningitis* and Pertussis. During her career she was given professional development opportunities to attend classes at the Center for Disease Control and other institutions and to train and share these experiences with colleagues.
