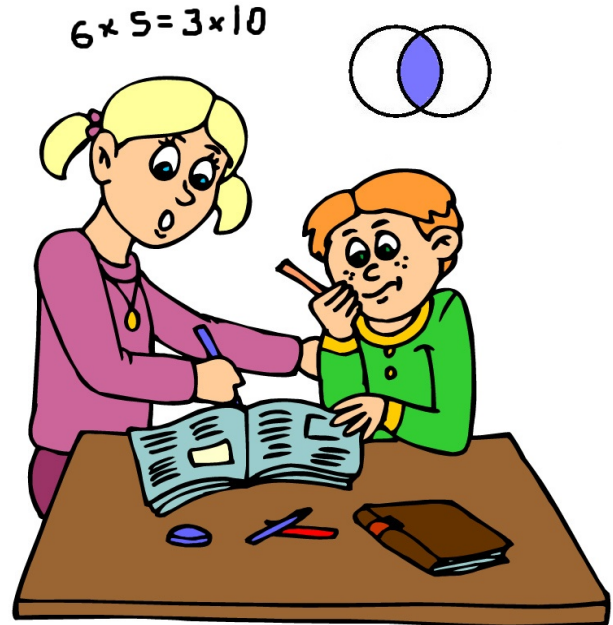
Elementary: grades 3-5

What's a Math Circle?

It is a junior math club for children interested in mathematics. This year we open a group for students in grades 3-5.

Why?

The purpose of the Math Circle is to introduce children to interesting mathematical ideas that are not taught in school, work on challenging problems, discuss some important concepts at a greater depth than is usually done in school, develop logic and reasoning skills, and, very importantly, have fun with mathematics.



Who is it for?

The Math Circle is free and is open to students in grades 3-5. If your child wants to learn more mathematics and is ready for some challenges, sign him/her up for the Math Circle!

When and Where?
