More Do's and Don'ts For Power Tools: DO:

- Remove damaged equipment from use immediately.
- Use three-prong grounding extension cords with all equipment requiring three-prong plugs.
- Match plugs with outlets.
- Use only specially approved tools for work in areas that are wet or contain flammable liquids.
- Keep body parts and clothes away from the point of operation and power train.



• **Don't** let cords drag on the floor.

• Don't use cords to raise or lower equipment.

• Don't fasten cords with staples, nails, or other means that could damage cord insulation.

• Don't plug or unplug equipment with wet hands.

• Don't handle a wet cord unless you're wearing

insulating protective equipment.
