# **Scholarship Award Guidelines**

Congratulations! Fresno State is pleased to offer you a scholarship for the 2014/2015 academic year. If you plan to attend any other institution, you must decline this award as this offer is only valid for those who will enroll at Fresno State.

By accepting this award, you agree to abide by the following:

- \* Maintain full-time enrollment
- \* Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA
- \* Notify the Scholarship Office of any changes of major or degree objective
- \* Submit a thank you letter addressed to the donor (see instructions below)

Failure to meet the above requirements may result in the following:

- \* Delayed disbursement of funds
- \* Forfeiture of award
- \* Repayment of disbursed funds

**Thanking the donor**: This is very important! Scholarship donors are generous and caring people who unselfishly give money to support the educational endeavors of students like you. They typically ask for nothing in return, but receiving a well written thank you letter from a student lets the donor know that his or her scholarship was greatly appreciated. We ask that you acknowledge their generosity by sending a brief note of appreciation to:

Please make sure to indicate the name of the scholarship you received in your thank you letter. Your letter reminds them why they gave in the first place and often helps secure continuing funds for future students. Need help on writing a thank you letter? **Disbursement of funds**: Awards are traditionally offered for the academic year and are disbursed at the beginning of the fall and spring semester. However, some awards may only be for a single semester. Please reference your Fresno State Financial Aid award screen by logging in to https://my.fresnostate.edu and click on "Student Center." Under the "Finances" header, select "View Financial Aid" to see how your funds are allocated. Your award will appear on your student account after you have accepted the award and after the Scholarship Office confirms your eligibility for this award. Please note it may take a few weeks for the Scholarship Office to confirm your eligibility and post the award on your Financial Aid screen.

Fresno State scholarship awards will not automatically payoff or pay down your tuition fees before the payment due date. This is your responsibility. Your scholarship will be electronically credited to your student account when all requirements for disbursement have been met, but no earlier than one week before the beginning of the semester. If fees are owed to Fresno State at the time your scholarship is disbursed, the funds will be applied towards the outstanding balance. If you have a zero balance, or your award exceeds what is currently owed, then the remaining balance will be disbursed to you through your Fresno State Choice Card.

Special arrangements can be made to defer the fee payment until your scholarship funds are available. To request a tuition deferment, you must contact the Scholarship Office at least one week before the fee payment deadline to make arrangements. #### **GETTING STARTED**

Congratulations! As a scholarship recipient, your hard work has been recognized, and your award has been made possible by the generous support of Fresno State alumni and friends. Now is your opportunity to acknowledge the thoughtful generosity to your college education.

- Gratitude should be expressed immediately; don't wait to write.
- $\bullet$  Use 8 ½ x 11 quality bond paper, your own personal stationery or an appropriate note card.
- Date letters by semester: "Fall 2013" or "Spring 2014".
- Type or use legible handwriting. Many donors are elderly.
- One page is sufficient. Be clear and concise.
- PROOFREAD! You communicate your intelligence with correct grammar and spelling.

Letters with errors or little content will be returned for rewrites.

## WHAT DO I WRITE? A Step-by-Step Guide

#### 1) Greet the Donor

Write to the donor or organization, not the selection committee. If you don't know the donor simply address:

"To the Family of the XXXX Memorial Scholarship"

or if it is a Foundation:

"To the Board Members of the XXXX Foundation."

#### 2) Express Your Gratitude

- Write sincerely with an active voice.
- Mention the scholarship by name.
- Do not directly mention "money" or request additional financial support.

"Thank you so much for your generosity."

"It is an honor to be chosen for the ABC Family Scholarship."

#### 3) Demonstrate the Impact

Share how being a student at Fresno State is impacting your life and what you enjoy most. For example:

- Why you chose Fresno State.
- Your course of study.
- Community service activities.

- Accomplishments, awards or honors you are proud of.
- Interests outside of your studies.

#### 4) Look Forward

Share your plans for the future: trips, activities, graduation or prospective job.

"Upon completion of my studies I plan to pursue a career in teaching."

Let them know how this scholarship has helped to further your education.

#### 5) Grace... Thank Again

"Thanks again for your gift."

"Thanks again. I appreciate the scholarship assistance."

#### 6) Signing off

"Sincerely," "Warm Regards,"
"Yours Truly," "With Sincere
Thanks," etc.

Proofread the entire letter, then **sign** your name clearly.

#### 7) Addressing the Envelope

Address the envelope to Donor & Volunteer Relations.
