
Course Substitution Process

The biggest, and most misunderstood, issue:

No matter how the request is submitted, courses that are not equivalent (articulated) cannot be used for prerequisite checking purposes during the registration process.

BENEFITS

- > Decreases registration complications
- New policy increases articulation
- Increase in articulation = more robust degree audit system
- Students will take less unnecessary courses
- Decrease in course substitution requests
- Electronic workflow designed to facilitate both course substitution and articulation requests (ARRC) – all paperless
- Provides <u>transparency</u> and useful <u>statistics</u>
