- Parenting Skills
- Civics and Citizenship
- English As a Second Language

Certificate Program Structure

Participants are awarded a certificate when they:

- Complete all class work
- Attend 80% of the 9-week course
- Score an 80% or better on the final exam

Program certificates are awarded during Fresno State Parent University night, held at the end of each 9-week cohort. Families are invited to attend and celebrate the achievements of their parents. Program certificates are signed by the local superintendent or principal and President Castro.
