

AB 1274

This bill would establish in statute the California Partnership for the San Joaquin Valley. The bill would incorporate language from 2006, 2008, and 2010 Governor Executive Orders to, among other things, require the Partnership to identify projects and programs that will improve the economic vitality of the San Joaquin Valley. The bill would require the Partnership, on and after January 1, 2021, to report to the Legislature on its progress.

California Partnership for the San Joaquin Valley

Formed in June 2005, the Partnership is an unprecedented public-private partnership focused on improving the region's economic vitality and quality of life for the +4 million residents who call the San Joaquin Valley home.
